## China's Submission on Potential Topics for the 6<sup>th</sup> Meeting of Durban Forum

China welcomes the output made in Marrakech on further enhancing capacity building of Developing country Parties both under the Convention and the Paris Agreement. In accordance with paragraph 10 of the decision 16 of COP 22 (FCCC/CP/2016/10/Add.2), China would like to submit the following views on the potential topics of the 6<sup>th</sup> Durban Forum:

The Durban Forums is an opportunity and platform or Parties and stake-holders to present their experiences and lessons learned on capacity building issue. The outcomes of the Durban Forums provide important information for corresponding works. Currently, there is need to set up the connection between work of the Durban Forum and the Paris Committee on Capacity Building (PCCB). In line with the topic of the 1st PCCB, China proposes the following topics to be considered at the 6th meeting of the Durban Forum, which will be held at SBI 46 back-to-back with the 1st meeting of the PCCB,

- Capacity building gaps and needs of Developing country Parties for the National Determined Contribution (NDC) implementation
- Capacity building in facilitating Developing country Parties to take actions on both mitigation and adaptation

The spirit of Paris Agreement is to motivate the maximum implementation on climate change actions. The outcomes of the 6<sup>th</sup> Durban Forum on above topics, especially the good experience and lessons learned, will help the work the PCCB and other relevant bodies established under the Convention, other entities to enhance the effectiveness of capacity building.
