General key points



- Non-market approaches (NMA) have great potential including to assist parties to implement their NDC in the context of sustainable development and poverty eradication
- SBSTA has to undertake a work programme (WP) to
 - enhance linkages and create synergies between, inter alia, mitigation, adaptation, finance, technology transfer and capacity building
 - facilitate implementation and coordination of NMA
- Timeline
 - SBSTA 47 & 48: define the steps of the work programme (WP)
 - SBSTA 49: recommend a CMA decision to adopt and launch the WP
 - -Jan. 2019: start the WP
 - Dec. 2020: aim to finalise and launch the WP
- Avoid duplication of work with existing instruments, institutions and agenda items

Q1 – How to facilitate coordination of NMA and create linkages and synergies?

This will be identified during Step 4 of the work programme

Main objectives of the WP are to identify:

- How to enhance linkages and create synergies
- How to facilitate implementation and coordination of NMA
- Which activities / structures could deliver this
- How to avoid duplication, for example
 - by using existing structures and instruments
 - by referring agenda items where the issues are already addressed



Q3 – organisational arrangements for the framework

- Overarching issues general preamble (to be defined at the end)
- NMAs under the framework
 - Must comply with para (a) and (b) and (c) of Art 6.8
 - Are non-tradeable
 - Are holistic, integrated and balanced
- Governance of the framework will be identified during the WP (Committee? Forum? Sharing approach?)
- Functions of the framework is 'to promote NMA' (Art 6.9) through activities / structure that should be identified during the WP
- Transparency Guidance on transparency and reporting for Parties using NMA
- Interlinkages With many items, as it is cross-cutting while avoiding duplication





Conclusions

On the basis of submissions, presentations, and interventions by Parties, co-facilitators should

- Identify
 - Areas of convergence
 - Areas of divergence
 - Areas for further work; and
- Prepare draft conclusions for discussion during SBSTA 47 including a mandate to produce draft text for the Work Programme to be agreed next year
