#### **Organizational matters**

• Elected Monika and Orville as its co-chairs for a term of one year.

## Establishing a clearing house for risk transfer that serves as a repository for information on insurance and risk transfer

- Intersessional group of champions to:
  - (i) Identify and engage potential partners, agree on their roles in the development and maintenance of the clearing house (UNFCCC to serve as a gateway of the clearing house);
  - (ii) Develop a 'dummy/mock-up/initial' version of the clearing house, using the 'look and feel', presented at Excom 5, as an initial basis;
  - (iii) Present, for feedback, the 'dummy/mock-up/initial' clearing house jointly with partners, for electronic feedback by members.

### Establishing a task force to develop recommendations for integrated approaches to avert, minimize and address displacement related to the adverse impacts of climate change

• Took note of the progress made in operationalization of the Task Force on Displacement and look forward to receiving inputs from the Task Force in future meetings.
