Dr. Al Binger is Energy Science Advisor at the Caribbean Community Climate Change Centre and SIDS DOCK Coordinator for the Small Island Developing States (SIDS) Sustainable Energy Initiative, and former Science Advisor and Technical Coordinator to the Alliance of Small Island States (AOSIS).

He is the former Professor and Director for the University of the West Indies Centre for Environment and Development, and since 2003, Visiting Professor at Saga University, Japan, involved in research on Ocean Thermal Energy Conversion (OTEC).

He is the former Chair, Strategic Planning for the Global Environment Division, Rockefeller Foundation, in New York, and founder of the Biomass Users (BUN) Network, Costa Rica.

As former Director for Research at the Scientific Research Council, Jamaica, he headed Agro-21, responsible for identifying and promoting opportunities for private and public investment in non-food agriculture.
