

#### **Obstacles to enhanced communication**

"To fulfill its mandate towards informed action on GEC in the region, the IAI must identify appropriate audiences for the scientific information it produces and improve mechanisms of communication" (FCCC/SBSTA/2007/MISC.8)

"In order for SBSTA to facilitate an enhanced two-way communication and cooperation, Parties and research organizations may wish to understand current obstacles and identify strategies that can be used to overcome these obstacles resulting in enhanced communication" (FCCC/SBSTA/2007/MISC.8)

## **Challenge 1**


•Identify a mechanism to channel global environmental change research information to most relevant audience (eg. governmental units, international fora) to strengthen science/policy interface for decision-making
