

in the Punakha-Wangdi and Chamkhar Valleys


#### Three Components


- 1. Artificial lowering of water level in Thorthormi Lake
- 2. Increase capacity for disaster risk management in affected valleys
- 3. Installing Technical Early Warning System for glacial lake outburst floods
- Funded by LDCF, RGOB, UNDP, Austrian Development Agency and the WWF-Bhutan (USD 8.273 million)
- Project period: 5 yrs (commencing 2008)

## Punakha-Wangdi GLOF EWS, Bhutan











- 1. Risk reduction from climate-induced floods and landslides
- 2. Enhanced adaptive capacity at community level
- 3. Enhanced national capacity for managing climate risks
- 3.1 Enhanced quality, availability, and transfer of real time climate data in all Dzongkhags
- 3.2 Increased effectiveness of National Weather Forecasting and Flood Warning Center (NWFFWC)




## NAPA II: Component 3


#### **Automatic Weather Stations (AWS)**

- 34 existing "Class C" Manual stations will be up graded to AWS (with real-time data transfer capability);
- 26 new AWS will be installed at new locations (with real-time data transfer capability);
- 11 snow gauge measurement facilities will be added to AWS on selected locations.

#### **Automatic Water Level Monitoring Stations (AWLS)**

- 11 existing manual water level monitoring stations (AWLS) will be upgraded to automatic AWLS;
- 28 automatic water level monitoring stations (AWLS) will be installed on selected locations;
- On six sites in critical sub-basin outlets a cable system for discharge measurement will be incorporated within the AWLS, to help flood forecasting and modeling works;
