Progress made in relation to support provided (on NAPs)

Accessing funding for NAPs from the GCF

- □ Five (5) NAP proposals approved so far, under the USD 3 million modality;
- ☐ Funding for two (2) of these (Liberia, Nepal) had been disbursed;
- □ A number of countries (thirty-four, 34) had also submitted proposals, awaiting approval
- Most of the submission are made through multilateral implementing entities



Progress made in relation to support provided (on NAPs)

LDC Expert Group

☐ Continued engagement with the GCF secretariat on ways to enhance the process to access support for NAPs. ☐ Five (5) regional training **workshops** on NAPs in 2017; **Integrative Framework for NAPs and SDGs** developed and applied at the training workshops, to guide countries on how to concurrently achieve adaptation and development goals; ☐ Country case studies on NAPs (**Open NAPs**) to provide a quick overview of how a NAP can be executed at the national level: ☐ Two regional NAP Expos to promote greater interaction among countries and to enhance collaboration with various partners at the regional levels; ☐ Further development of **NAP Central**, including the NAP tracking tool and the event pages for workshops and Expos.

Progress made on implementation of NAPAs and LDC work programme

A total of 249 NAPA projects approved for funding from the LDCF since its establishment in 2001
 As at 30 June, 20 NAPA proposals (totalling USD 126.3 million) had been technically cleared by the GEF secretariat and were awaiting the availability of resources from the LDCF
 As at 9 August 2017, the total cumulative donor pledges to the LDCF amounted to USD 1.23 billion
 At least five LDCs had revised and/or updated their NAPAs.



Emerging challenges expressed by countries from the NAP workshops

The challenges and needs fall under four broad categories:
 Having the best available data and tools for assessments;
 Making swift tangible progress in accessing funding from the GCF for NAPs;
 Building long-term capacity for adaptation planning and implementation;
 Having training materials that countries can use/apply at the national level.

The LEG will include these to inform ongoing support to the LDCs

Cross-cutting issues	 Strengthening the considerations of women, children and other vulnerable groups Developing and implementing integrated approaches that can build on co-benefits and manage trade-offs between adaptation and mitigation Capturing and sharing experiences, best practices and lessons learned Enhancing the engagement of Non-Party Stakeholders (esp. regional centres and networks, private sector, etc.) to support the countries on adaptation planning and implementation



Work on two of the mandates has been concluded

- Modalities to recognize the adaptation efforts of developing country Parties:
 - Synthesis reports on adaptation efforts, and on specific themes;
 - High-level event for presenting the efforts, and a summary thereof;
 - Showcasing of adaptation efforts at various events
- Methodologies on taking the necessary steps to facilitate the mobilization of support for adaptation in developing countries:
 - Enhancing enabling environments, policy frameworks, etc.
 - Assessment and prioritization of adaptation needs;
 - Engaging on adaptation planning and implementation
 - Making efforts to access available resources, etc.
- Work on methodologies on reviewing the adequacy and effectiveness of adaptation and support requires further technical work.
