



Workshop to Support the Intermediate Review of the Doha work programme on Article 6 of the Convention

Information for participants

This document answers commonly asked questions and provides a range of information to facilitate your participation and stay during the workshop.

How do I get from the airport to Bonn Center?

- Direct trains run between Frankfurt and the Bonn Hauptbahnhof (central station). Travel information for trains can be found here: <https://www.bahn.de/i/view/USA/en/index.shtml>
- A direct bus line “SB60” (airport express) runs from Cologne/Bonn airport to the Bonn Hauptbahnhof.

Where is the workshop venue?

The workshop for National Focal Points of Article 6 of the Convention will be held at the UN Campus in the “Langer Eugen” building on the 19th floor. The room allocated to the workshop is LEU 1916. A map with the location of the UN Campus can be found in Annex I.

Please note:

When entering the UN Campus you will have to present security with an ID in exchange for a visitor’s badge. When leaving the UN Campus please remember to return your visitor’s badge to security in order to obtain back your ID.

How do I get to the workshop venue?

By subway:

- Take subway (U-Bahn) line 16, 63 or 66 from Bonn Hauptbahnhof towards Bad Godesberg/Königswinter
- Get off at “**Heussallee/Museumsmeile**” station and follow the “UN Campus” signage.
- Walk straight ahead until you reach the UN Campus. The walking distance from the subway station is about 250 metres.

By bus:

Take bus no. 610 or 611 from Bonn Hauptbahnhof or Bad Godesberg Centre to “**Deutsche Welle**” station. The station is right in front of the main entrance of the UN Campus.

Where/How do I get my workshop badge?

Where/How do I claim my DSA?

Workshop participants eligible for funding and have not yet received their daily subsistence allowance (DSA) can collect it as a traveller’s cheque at the office located right next to the meeting room 1916 in the morning during the first coffee break. The cheque can be cashed out in United Nations Campus “Langer Eugen”, ground floor in the offices of our in-house travel agency Westtours. **You will need to present a copy of your passport or other official identification (with photo ID) and your flight ticket and boarding pass stubs when claiming your DSA.**
