## Steps undertaken in accessing funding process:

- Institutional arrangements & good governance;
- Mobilization of funding through multilateral agencies;
- Accreditation by the Adaptation Fund (November 2012);
- Approval of the first project (Adaptation to Climate Change Project in Oasis Zones): US \$ 10 M;
- Accreditation by the GCF (March 2016);
- Approval of the fisrt project (Promotion of Argan Orchad in degraded environement): US \$ 40 M;
- Submission for the PPF (Modernization of Irrigation project);
- Preparation and submission of ADA Entity Work Program
- Submission of ADA Readiness Proposal (May 2017)





## **Major challenges**:

- Pilot Accredited Entity (AE) in Morocco;
- Language barrier (Templates, translation, communication...etc);
- Additional requirements such as the formalization of procedures, exp: ESS policy, and the investigation function;
- Limited financial and technical support (GIZ support on ADA's accredition process);

## **Lessons learnt:**

- Continous learning by doing accreditation processus;
- Importance of good governance, internal dynamic, visibility, high motivation and appropriation;
- Capitalization and inspiration from the experiences of other NIEs (south-south cooperation).
