 - -Facilitate information exchange and integrated assessments
 - Identify specific adaptation needs and concerns

 - -for further exchange of experience
 - -for promoting adaptation planning and implementation in the region
 - -For facilitating concrete action on adaptation through cooperative action

Structure

- The assessment process
 - Systematic observation, data and monitoring
 - Impact, vulnerability and adaptation assessment
- Adaptation planning and implementation
 - Agriculture and food security, water resources, coastal zones, health, mountainous regions; and roundtable on multilateral support
- Regional collaboration
 - South-South and North-South



Fate of the outcomes

- Outcomes will be a direct result of the interactive plenary discussions and output of the breakout groups
- Outcomes will feed into the UNFCCC negotiations at SBI 26 and COP 13 on what future action is necessary to advance adaptation in developing countries
