An exciting initiative that will provide grants to selected accredited national implementing entities to provide one-on-one peer assistance to countries seeking accreditation.



- Support in one or more of the following:
 - identifying potential NIE candidates;
 - assisting NIE candidates in the preparation of applications to be submitted to the Fund;
 - providing support and advice during the application process.
- Selected supporting NIEs:
 - ANII, CSE, MINIRENA, PIOJ, UCAR
