Sixth meeting of the Adaptation Committee Bonn, Germany 29 September–1 October 2014

Pursuant to decisions 1/CP.16 and 2/CP.17, I am pleased to notify constituencies of admitted non-governmental organizations that the sixth meeting of the Adaptation Committee will take place at the United Nations Campus (also known as “Langer Eugen”), in Bonn, Germany, from 29 September–1 October 2014.

The provisional agenda, as well as other details of the meeting, are being finalized and will soon be made available on the UNFCCC website.

In accordance with the modalities and procedures adopted by decision 2/CP.17, the meeting of the Adaptation Committee will be open to admitted observer organizations, except where otherwise decided by the Adaptation Committee. Given space limitations, participation will be limited to two representatives for each of the nine constituencies.

Representatives from NGO's nominated by the Constituency Focal Point must register for the meeting using the Observer Registration Form for NGO's, which is sent to Constituency Focal Points. Confirmation by the Constituency Focal Point is provided for in the form. The deadline for registration as an observer is **Monday, 04 August 2014**. In view of the need to confirm the arrangements for the meeting as early as possible, please be advised that the secretariat may not be in a position to process observer registration forms for NGOs received after this deadline.
