I: Background and context

- SBSTA 38 mandate: SBSTA invited the AC to provide recommendations in its next report on how the NWP provide support to the AC
- Paper identifies 3 types of possible support:
 - Joint activities to enhance synergy and coherence
 - Catalysing further actions with relation to the provision of information and knowledge products from partner organizations
 - Supporting engagement of adaptation stakeholders through existing modalities under the NWP



II: Proposed next steps

The AC may wish to agree on:

- Joined activities, such as:
 - Workshop on best practices and needs of local and indigenous communities & scoping paper
 - Information paper on national adaptation planning
- NWP contributions to information and knowledge products as identified by, e.g. activities 6 (list of regional centers), 15 (IPCC meeting), 18 (meeting on livelihoods and ED), 21 (reports) of the AC's work plan
- NWP contributions to stakeholder engagement in the context of, example the AC's communication and outreach strategy



III: Topics for further guidance

- **Short term**: What activities, including joint activities, could the NWP carry out to support the work of the AC for the period up to COP 20 (timing, modalities etc.)?
- **Medium and long-term**: Pending further reconsideration by the SBSTA, how could the NWP function as a technical wing of the Adaptation Committee in facilitating the generation, dissemination and application of data, information and knowledge on adaptation?
