Activity C.2: Provide capacity-building to chairs and members of UNFCCC constituted bodies and technical teams of the secretariat on how to integrate gender considerations into their respective areas of work and on meeting the goal of gender balance

- Capacity-building sessions held with Adaptation Committee, Excom of Warsaw International Mechanism on Loss and Damage, Paris Committee on Capacity Building, Technology Executive Committee
- Presentations on mandates also made to CDM EB, CGE, LEG, SCF with future capacity-building sessions to be planned. New constituted bodies yet to be formally approached
