- ❖ Providing technical / substantive support
 - for women delegates

- ❖ Strengthened reflection of gender perspectives in discussions and outcomes of processes
- ❖ Evidence-building (from women experts bringing their experiences and knowledge)
- ❖ Greater visibility/profiling of gender issues
- ❖ Broader support; more gender champions and advocates
- ❖ Greater interest in and appreciation of gender issues from a broad range of stakeholders

- ❖ Travel funds: how do we systematize to broaden beneficiaries and ensure equitable representation?
- ❖ Engagement of women's machineries related entities at the national level
- ❖ Implement modalities to achieve gender balance in co-leadership or rotating leadership positions
- ❖ Introducing of quotas for national delegations
- ❖ Addressing systemic inequalities to improve women's participation in scientific fields including climate change and negotiations
- ❖ Promote women's access to land, training and green technologies at the local level, to enable them to become leaders
- ❖ Engagement of men allies and the International Gender Champions
