- Gender Negotiation and Advocacy Training, including for women delegates and women's groups
- Enhancing understanding and developing tools to support a gender-responsive implementation of the Katowice package
- Tools, training, capacity-building to ensure on access to finance and implementation of gender-specific requirements of the Green Climate Fund and the Global Environment Fac.
