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- ❖ Capacity-building and training for government officials
 - With civil society and other stakeholders
- ❖ Organizing workshops, mentoring, exchange visits, developing guides, tools, elaboration of gender-sensitive criteria / indicators
- ❖ Areas:
 - gender mainstreaming in climate change policies and plans
 - gender-responsive budgeting; NDCs
 - development of gender-responsive project proposals
 - gender-responsive: DRR, climate-smart agriculture, climate-smart urban development, climate finance mechanisms, energy

- ❖ Create a community of practice and networks to share lessons, good practices, and solutions by various stakeholders on gender-responsive climate policies and actions
- ❖ Training of trainers on gender and climate change
- ❖ Capacity-building for collection, generation, utilisation and communication of data to design gender-responsive climate policies
- ❖ Enhancing grass-root level involvement, and promotion of women's access to climate information and decision making
- ❖ Gender Negotiation and Advocacy Training, including for women delegates and women's groups
- ❖ Enhancing understanding and developing tools to support a gender-responsive implementation of the Katowice package
- ❖ Tools, training, capacity-building to ensure on access to finance and implementation of gender-specific requirements of the Green Climate Fund and the Global Environment Fac.
