






■ Europe 2020 non-ETS GHG targets in % (change from 2005)




■ Europe 2030 non-ETS GHG targets in % (change from 2005)








- The Strategy is accompanied by the National Action Plan which consists of 57 actions in 10 sectors: Water, Soil, Coastal areas, Biodiversity, Agriculture, Forests, Health, Energy, Tourism and Infrastructure
- Annual revision of the strategy and the action plan is foreseen in the council
 of ministers' decision
