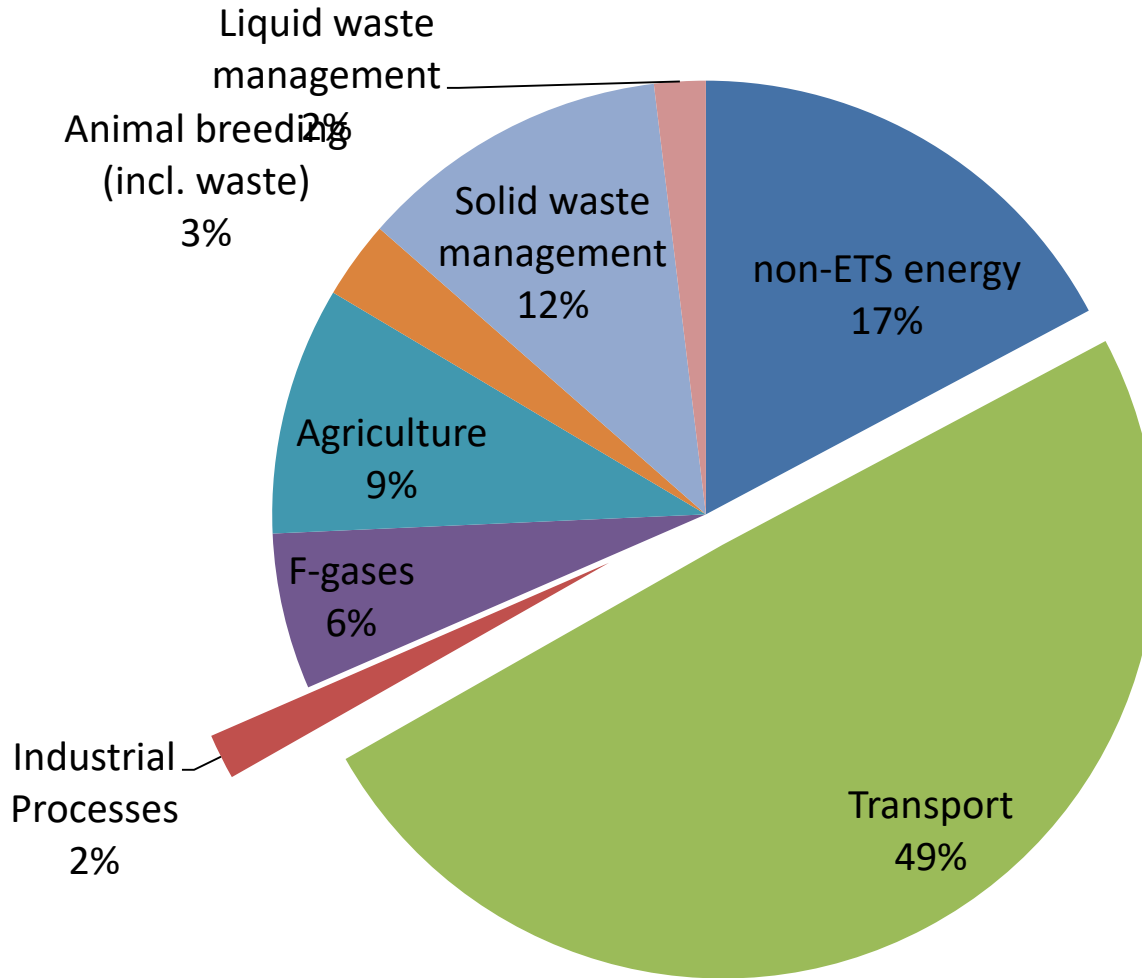

SECTORAL SHARE OF NON-ETS SECTORS TO NON-ETS NATIONAL EMISSIONS

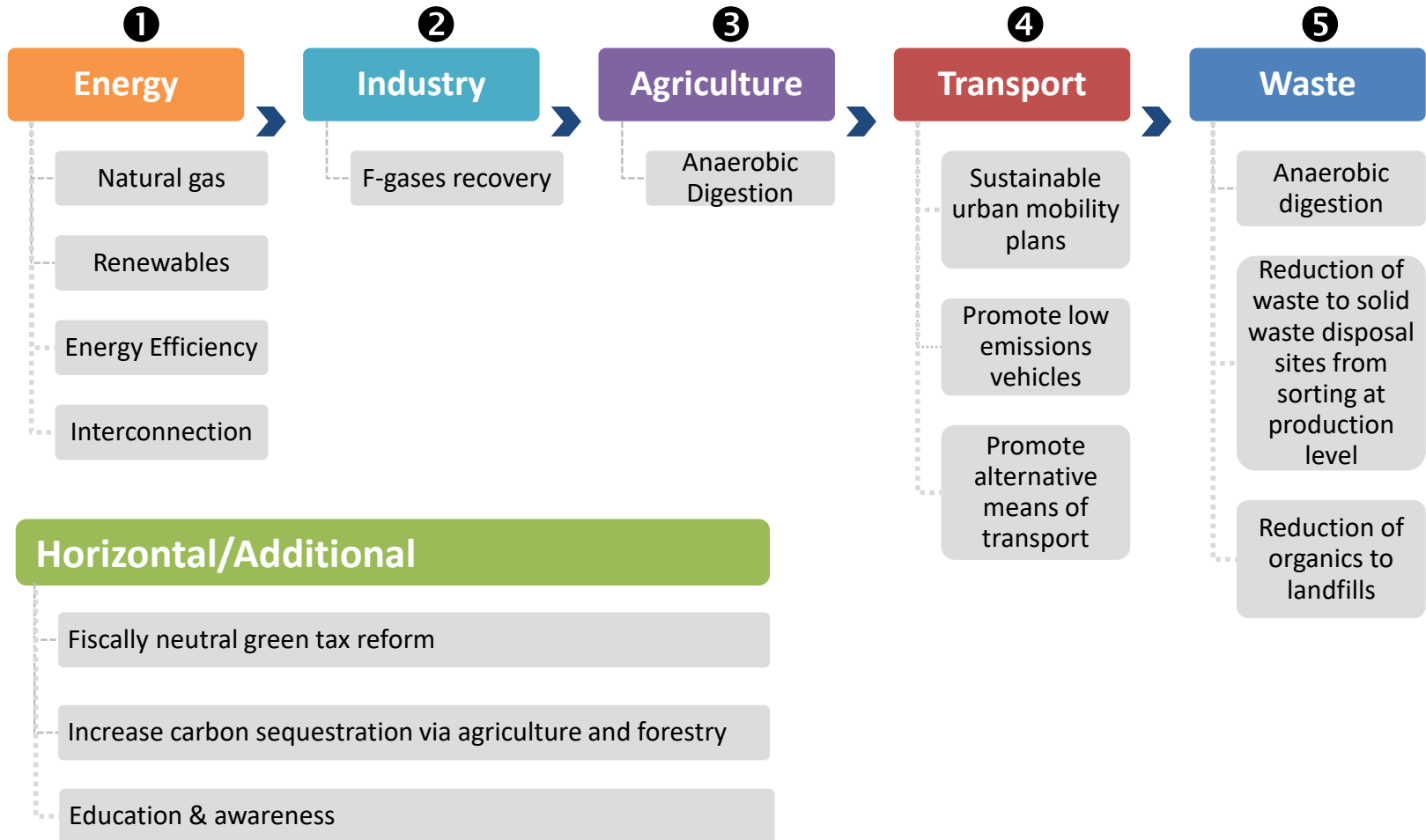

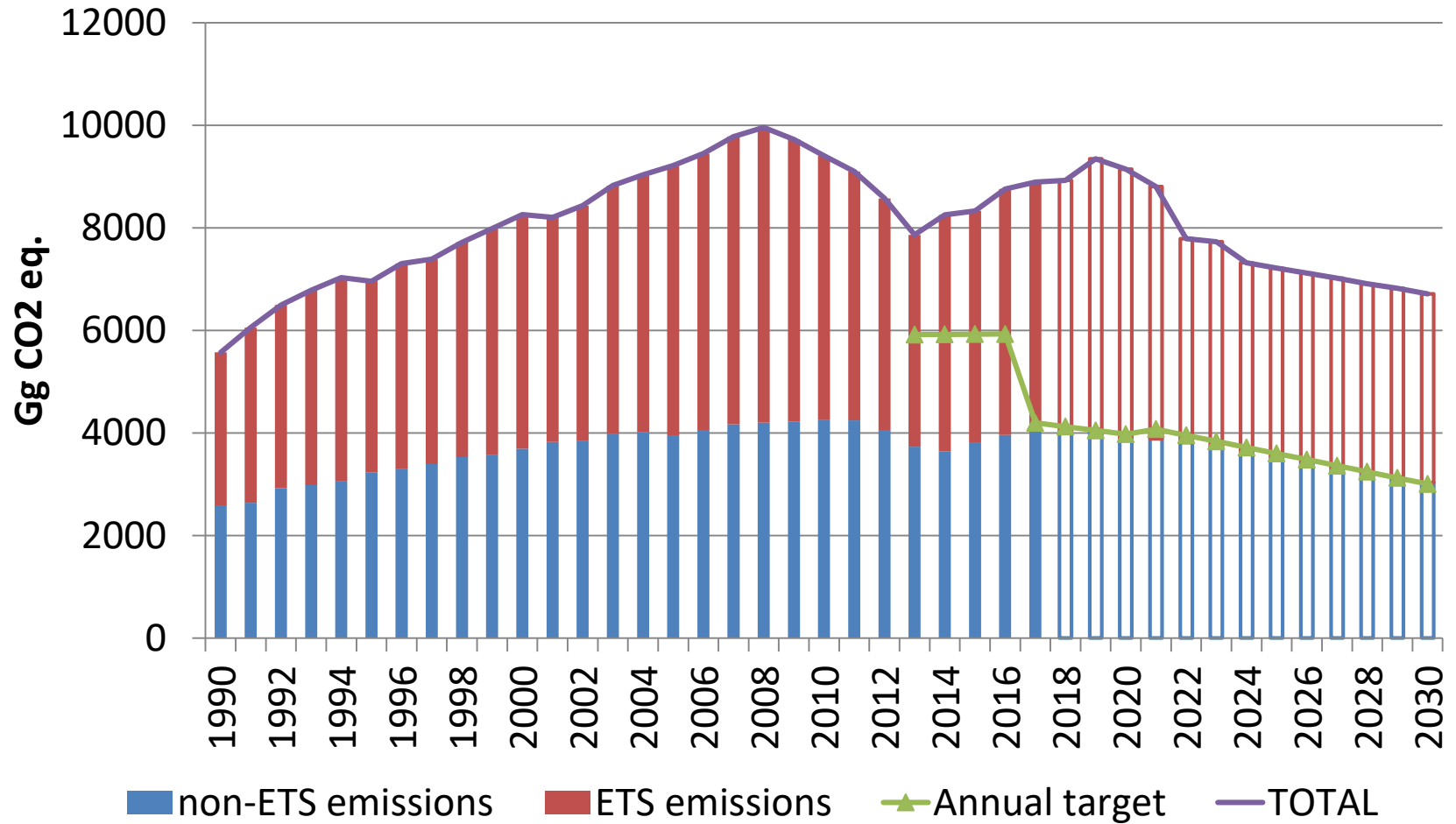
PROPOSED - FOR THE REDUCTION OF GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSIONS

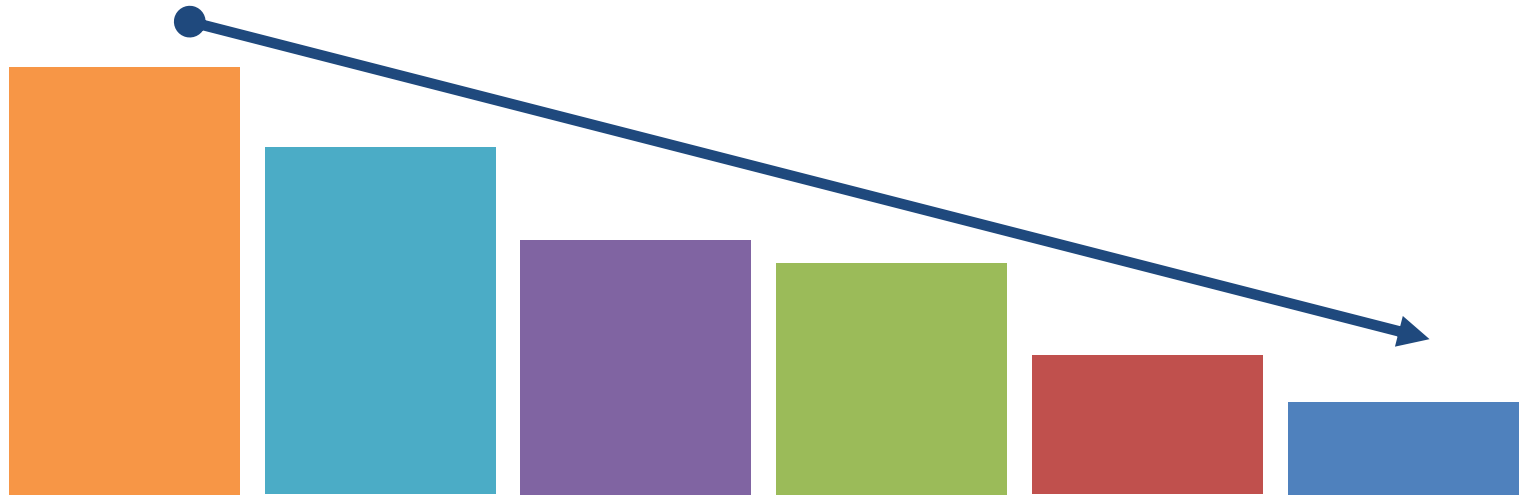


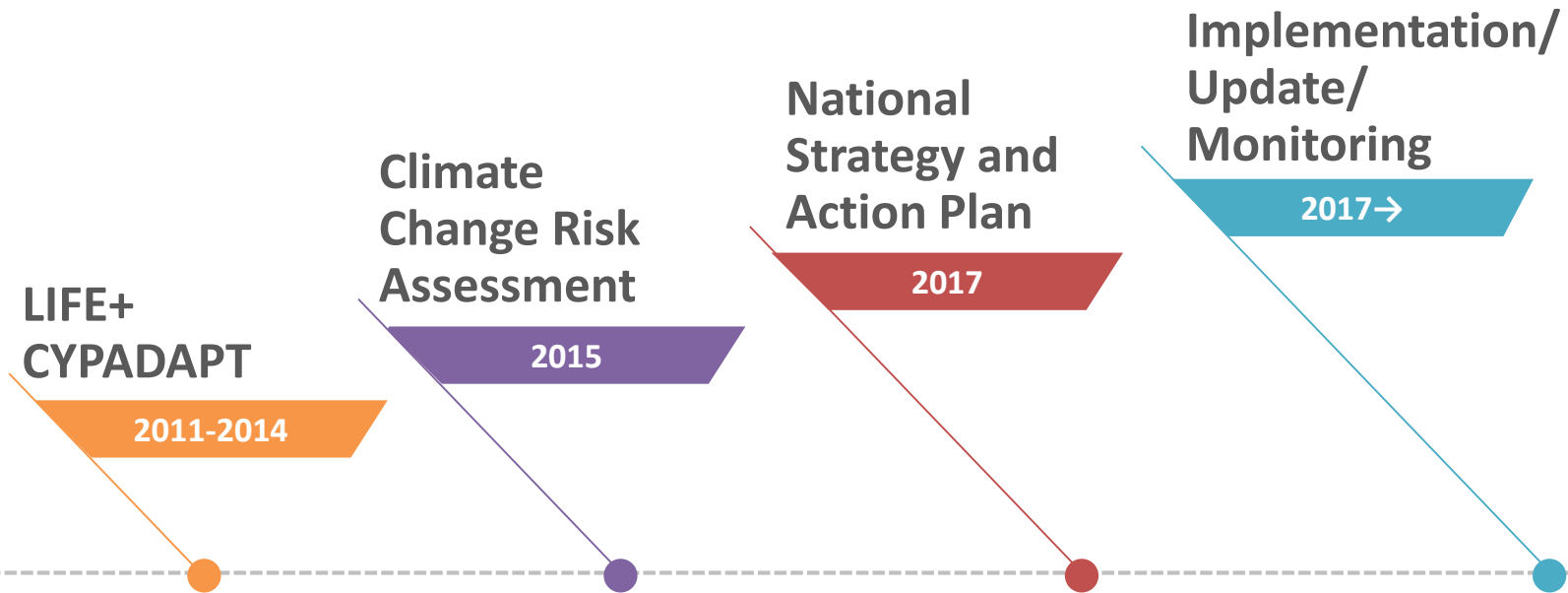

## CYPRUS AIMS TO ACHIEVE CARBON NEUTRALITY BY 2050





- The implementation of the Strategy aims at enhancing Cyprus' capacity to adapt to observed and projected climate change and aims to effectively prevent and address the negative impacts of climate change.
- The Strategy is accompanied by the National Action Plan which consists of 57 actions in 10 sectors: Water, Soil, Coastal areas, Biodiversity, Agriculture, Forests, Health, Energy, Tourism and Infrastructure
- Annual revision of the strategy and the action plan is foreseen in the council of ministers' decision

The Cyprus Climate Change Initiative aims at the development of an Action Plan to address the specific needs and challenges countries are facing in the EMME region to address and ameliorate the impact of climate change and advance mitigation actions in accordance with the Paris Agreement.
