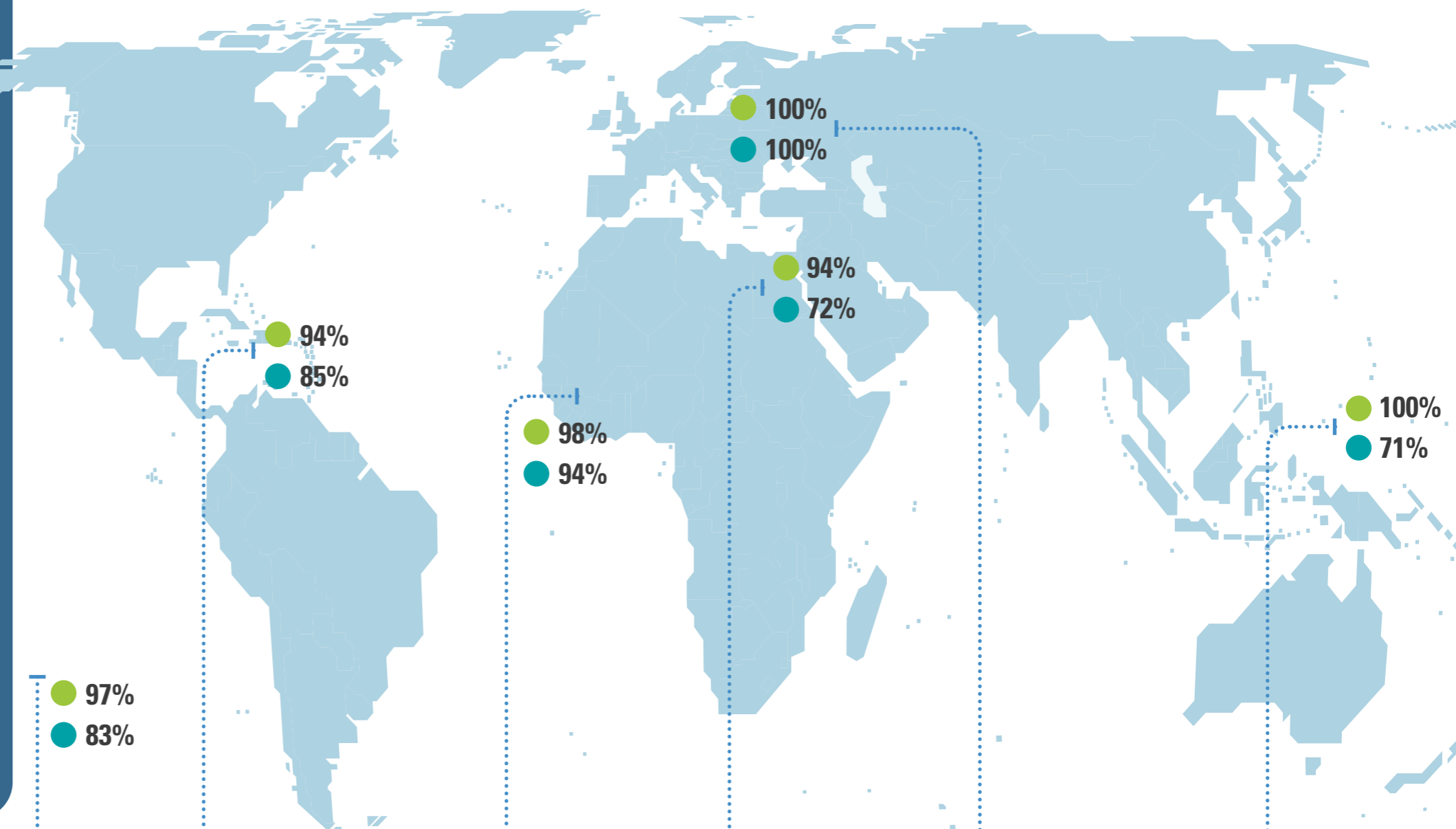
Mitigation in the agriculture and/or land use, land use change and forestry (LULUCF) sectors

97% of all the Small Island Developing States (SIDS) refer to **disaster risk reduction** in the national climate plans

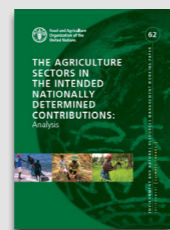
88% of all the Least Developed Countries (LDCs) refer to **food insecurity and malnutrition** as a climate risk in the national climate plans
