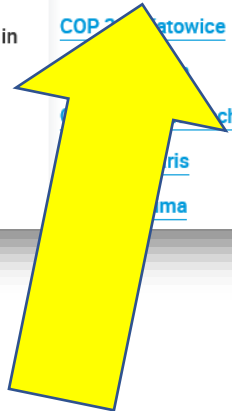

In-session workshop on the role of NGCCFPs

Description/Objective

At COP 25 Parties adopted the 5-year enhanced Lima work programme on gender and its gender action plan ([Decision 3/CP.25](#)) through which it encourages Parties to appoint and provide support for national gender and climate change focal points (NGCCFP) for climate negotiations, implementation and monitoring. The COP also requested the secretariat, with the contribution of the NGCCFPs, Parties and relevant organizations, to organize an in-session workshop at SB 52 to discuss and clarify the role and the work of the NGCCFP, that is to lead to the formulation of recommendations on the role (GAP Activity A.2).

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the secretariat organized a [virtual workshop series](#) in 2020, which will conclude with an in-person workshop at COP26.

The objective of this workshop is to allow NGCCFPs and Parties to reflect on and develop recommendations on the role of NGCCFPs. Experiences will be shared to inspire collaborative reflections.

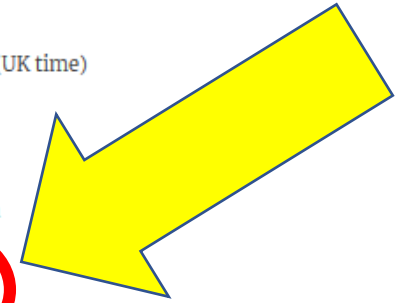

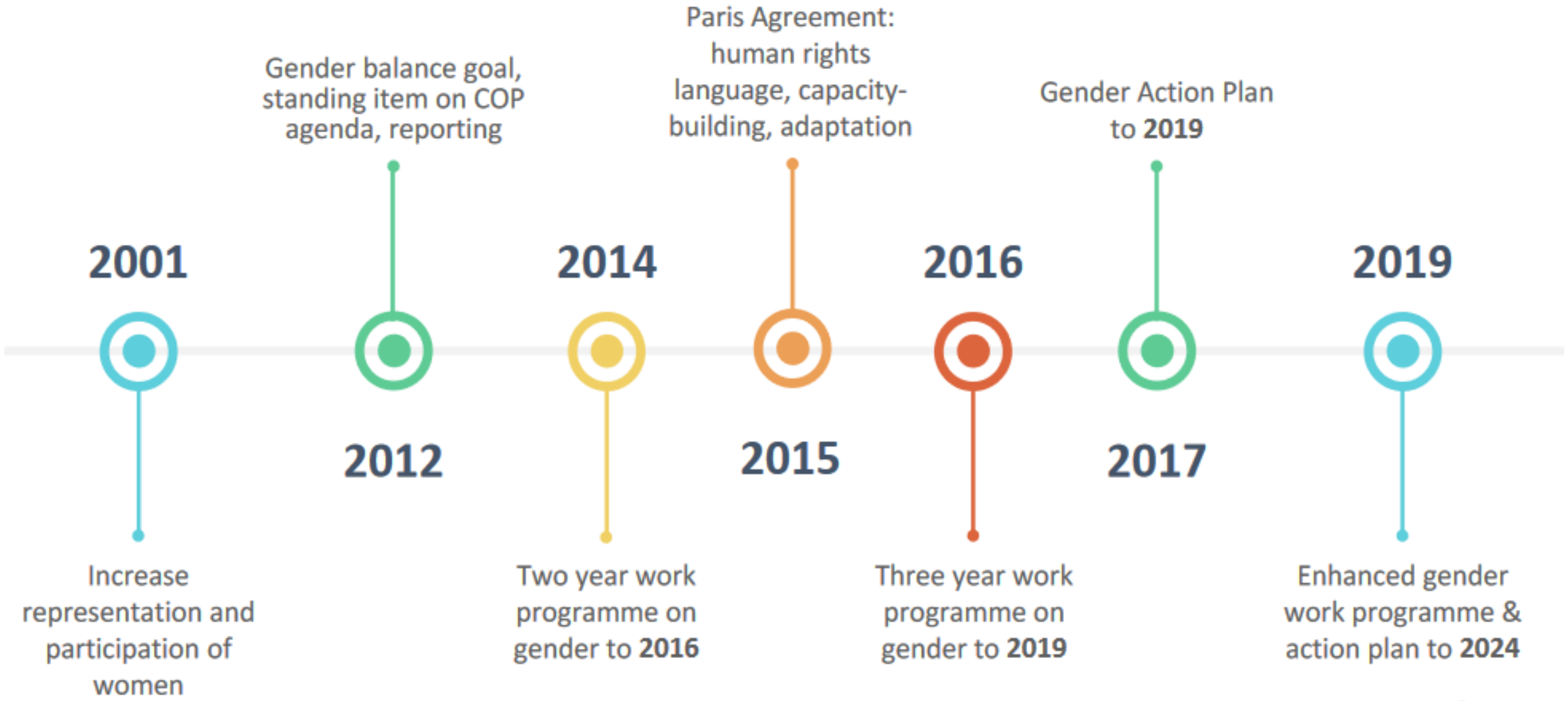

Gender under the UNFCCC





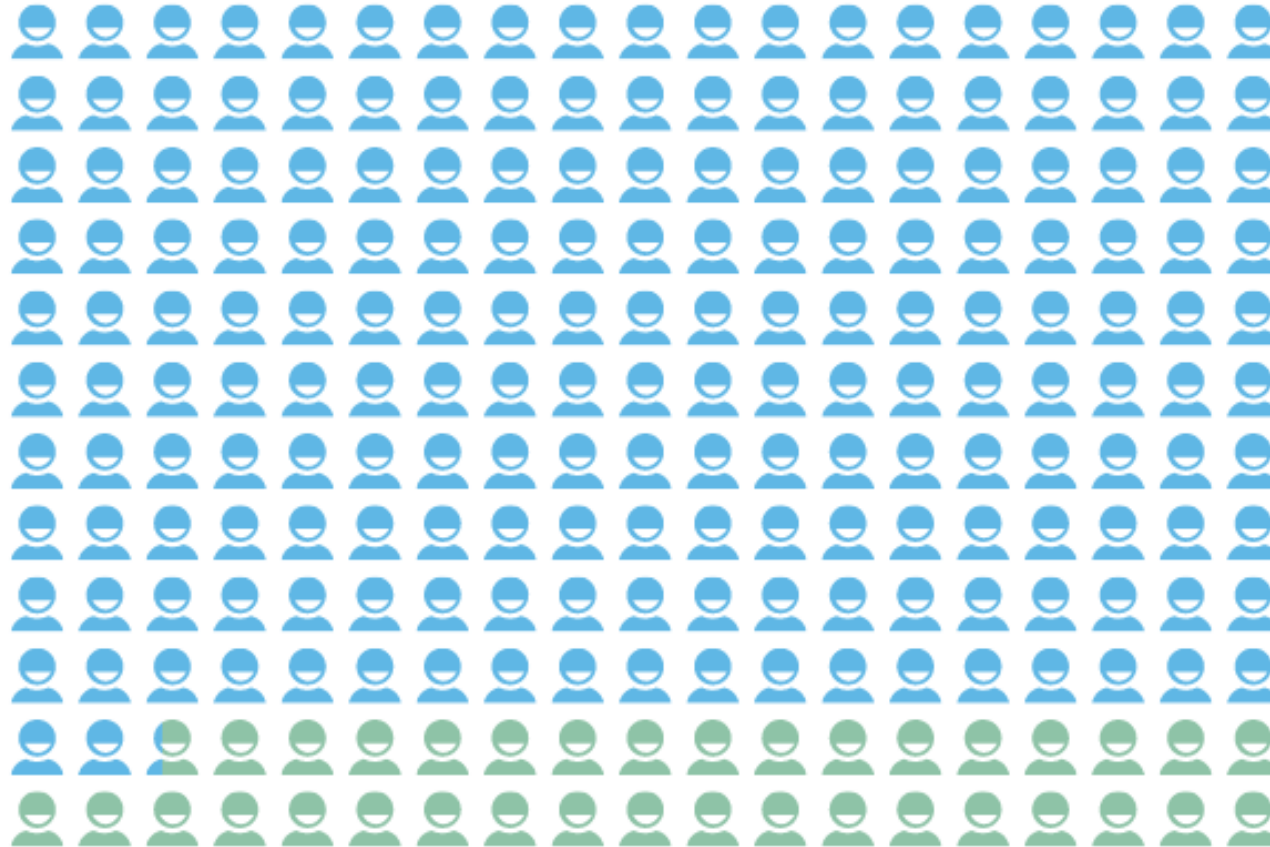

94 countries have appointed at least one NGCCFP

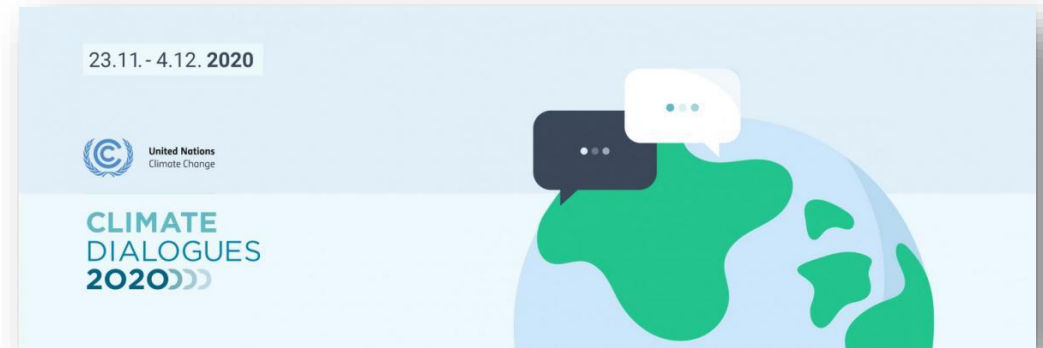

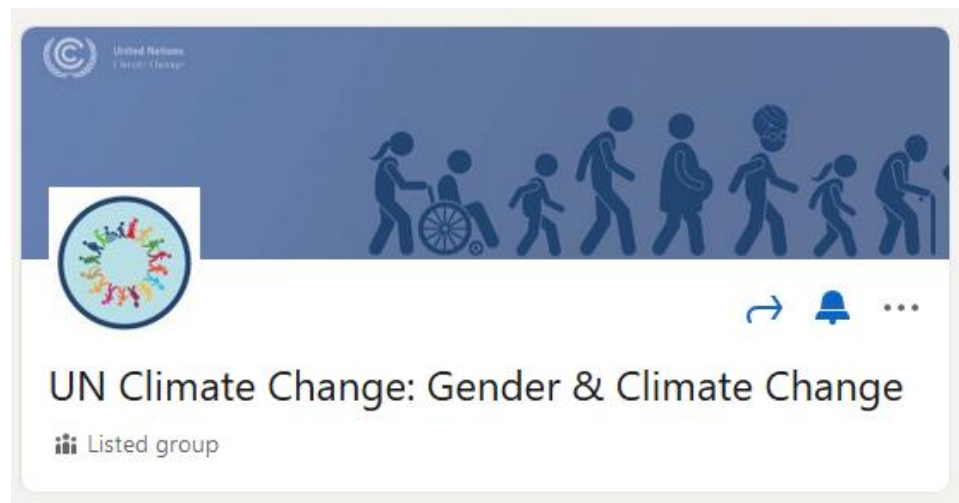
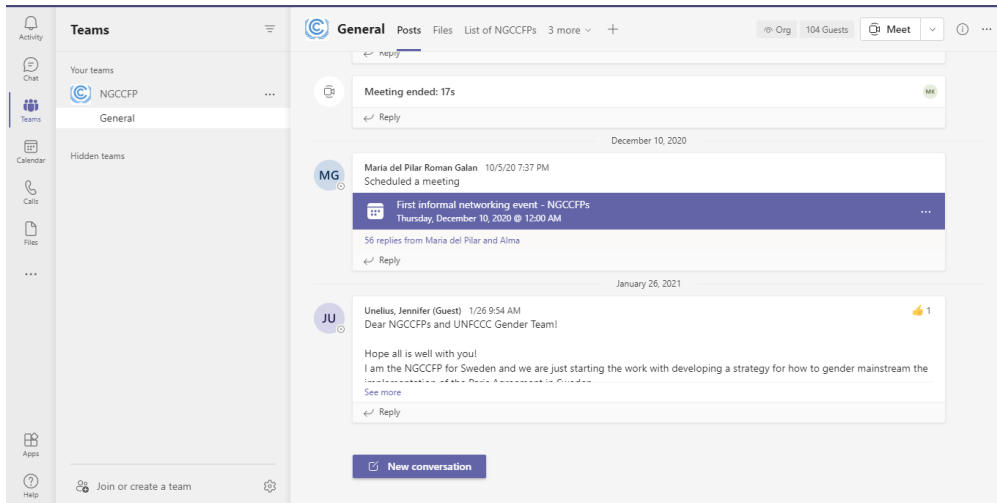
