
# IRI'S CLIMATE SERVICES APPROACH

### > Support development of climate products based on best available science

Challenge: Data gaps, insufficient coverage


Solution: ENACTS dataset

- Merges station data + satellite data
- Higher resolution, longer time series, quality controlled
- Online tools for data analysis and visualization
- Better availability, access and use of climate data



# Challenge: lack of medium tern information to inform decisions Solution: NextGen seasonal and sub-seasonal forecasts

- Systematic approach for designing, implementing, producing and verifying objective climate forecasts
- Tailored probabilistic forecasts at multiple timescales
- Ex: frequency of rainy/dry days in the target season, onset, duration of the rainy season(s); min/mean/max temperatures



# IRI'S CLIMATE SERVICES APPROACH

- > Convening / capacity building: decision-makers, policy makers, climate scientists
- > Coproduce tailored sectoral climate products

Challenge: "There is no data"; "We don't know what the needs are" Solution: Climate Academies (national/global)

- Develop functional, trusting relationship between providers and users
- Improve mutual understanding of needs + information available
- Tailored capacity building
- Institutional tools and mechanisms supporting delivery of relevant, timely information in appropriate format to the right people in climate-sensitive sectors.

Ex: dengue prediction, drought prediction, agro-climate advisories
