Facilitates work of reviewers (esp. help to orient and guide new reviewers)  
e.g., checklist pulls together important references for work in one place, i.e., reporting requirements, RPG guidance, previous findings, template for drafting findings



Ensures consistency across reviews

## Review approach

- Clarify that “ERT notes and questions” suggestions are not exhaustive but indicative of likely issues, ERT still needs to read report/tables
- Risk of prejudging outcomes
- Consider if sufficient for in-country reviews

## Usability/Accessibility

- Evaluate and address VTR application security compatibility issues (issues editing online, but also with downloaded file)
- Checklist, some basic restructuring could facilitate usability, i.e., moving RPG content to its own column, and moving expert assessment to follow recommendation/encouragement text column
- Report/checklist templates
  - Simple: Option to link or bypass instructions for more experienced reviewers, consider link for instructions
  - *More advanced: Report editing dashboard to facilitate work across document*
- Encourage experts to discuss potential questions with rest of ERT and RO to compose/formulate appropriately



- PAMs – nice but not necessary, include comparison table of previously reported PAMs and those in current submission
