Feedback on review tools



Review report template:

- UNFCCC Secretariat should pre-fill all data and information availably or the information that could be derived from Party's submission (including %, trends, etc...)
- Remove lengthily descriptions in the narrative which repeat the information already presented in the Party's submission to the extent possible. (Preferably just keep the tabular assessment format with transparent description of findings and triggers for recommendations and encouragements...in separate paragraphs)





Feedback on review tools



Checklist:

- UNFCCC Secretariat should pre-fill the previous recommendations and encouragements and all relevant data and information available from Party's submission
- Wording in template's 4th column in line which it is referring to prior recommendations could be improved "Prior recommendation(s) (IDR7/TTR4)".
- In column Expert Assessment Cell "Requirements met" it is not sufficiently clear whether the status (in the drop down status) is referring to prior recommendation(s) or to the an existing status of reporting requirement. Clear guidance on "Still assessing" status should be provided
- FTC Check list Table 9....NC-48 BR13 / Check list should provide celar guidance on assessing non-Annex II parties reporting on FTC. In addition there is no legend/description for text with Pink background.
- Consistency in referencing..... In general the referencing starts with NC and then BR, however in FTC p.11 NC53(51)/BR18....the referencing starts with BR and then NC (Assess in BR para 13 /NC para 48)
