I am pleased to invite United Nations organizations and admitted intergovernmental organizations to the 13th Focal Point Forum of the Nairobi work programme (NWP) during the 25th session of the Conference of the Parties.

The Focal Point Forum will be held under the guidance of the Chair of the SBSTA and will convene Parties, experts, and other interested stakeholders. The event will focus on the topic of oceans in accordance with the outcomes of the 50th session of the Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice.¹

The forum will foster engagement of government representatives, experts and expert organizations, including those from developing countries and those working on national adaptation plans, in order to build climate resilient sustainable development in coastal areas and oceans, as underscored by the recent IPCC Special Report on the Ocean and Cryosphere in a Changing Climate (SROCC)². The forum will also facilitate collaboration and partnerships among NWP partner organizations, Parties and other relevant organizations, could contribute to translating the key findings and gaps identified in the activities undertaken under the NWP into concrete adaptation actions on this topic.
