What worked well from the Doha work programme that could continue post 2020?

- Cooperation between ACE National Focal Points and YOUNGO
- ACE was kept on the agenda and dialogue continued
- Increasing attention on the topics of education, training, public participation and participation, access to information and international cooperation



Post 2020: What do we want to achieve?

- Dialogue to be continued
- More Focal Points to be assigned
- More financial and technical resources



What are the identified needs and possible actions to address them?

- ACE should be guided by a country-driven, holistic, and systematic approach.
- Strengthening the existing skills and capacity of the ACE national focal points is crucial.
- Fostering multi-stakeholder participation especially of youth and establishing partnerships should be emphasized and more funding needs to be secured.

What interlinkages and synergies are needed?

- Work collaboratively, internationally and intergenerationally
- Collaboration with young climate activists who already work on climate change education, capacity building and training
- Consult young people in setting up programmes on a national level
