## **Status**

- 3 March: Nomination of the 2023/2024 co-chairs by the SB chairs;
- 12 April: Communication of the topic of the 2023 Global Dialogues by the co-chairs; Accelerating just energy transition, including by:
  - Implementing policies and measures with global overview and country-specific experience;
  - Addressing financial, technological and capacity-building needs in this area, such as through international cooperation, including with non-Party stakeholders, and provision of support to developing countries;
  - Promoting sustainable development and understanding socioeconomic effects.
- 3-5 June: First Global Dialogue & Investment Focused Event in Bonn, Germany;
  - Renewable energy
  - Grid and energy storage
  - Energy efficiency
  - Carbon capture and utilization / storage
- 21 September: **Report** on the first global dialogue



## On the road to COP28

- 15-17 October: Second Global Dialogue and Investment Focused Event in Abu Dhabi, UAE on accelerating just energy transition in transport systems
  - Deploying and shifting to collective and non-motorized modes of transport
  - Energy and resource efficiency
  - Electrification of vehicles
  - Low and zero-carbon fuels
  - *New*: World Café format, pitch hub, discussion on structural barriers, technical non-paper
- Before COP 28: **Report** on the second global dialogue and **annual report** comprising a compilation of the individual dialogue reports
- At COP 28:
  - 1. Negotiating sessions under the SBs and the CMA with a view to recommending a draft decision for consideration and adoption, to consider progress, including key findings, opportunities and barriers in implementing the work programme
  - 2. Presentation by the co-chairs on the annual report at the **annual high-level ministerial round table on pre-2030 ambition**



# Links to the Global Stocktake

## Mandate

- to urgently scale up mitigation ambition and implementation in this critical decade in a manner that complements the global Stocktake
- Organizing two global dialogues focusing on an exchange of views, information and ideas and investment related events to bring together a multitude of stakeholders. <u>Other</u> <u>dialogues may be held in conjunction with existing events</u>, such as the regional climate weeks.

### In 2023

- Global Dialogues & Investment-focused events aim to become an impactful tool to drive ambition and implementation, facilitative and inspiring and bring together the "right" participants.
- The topics covered by the Mitigation Work Programme are also considered under the Global Stocktake "technical" phase (e.g. Synthesis report of the technical assessment paras 112-125).

#### In 2024 and beyond

• The "consideration of outputs" ought to give political signals that the MWP may consider in its work in 2024 and beyond.
