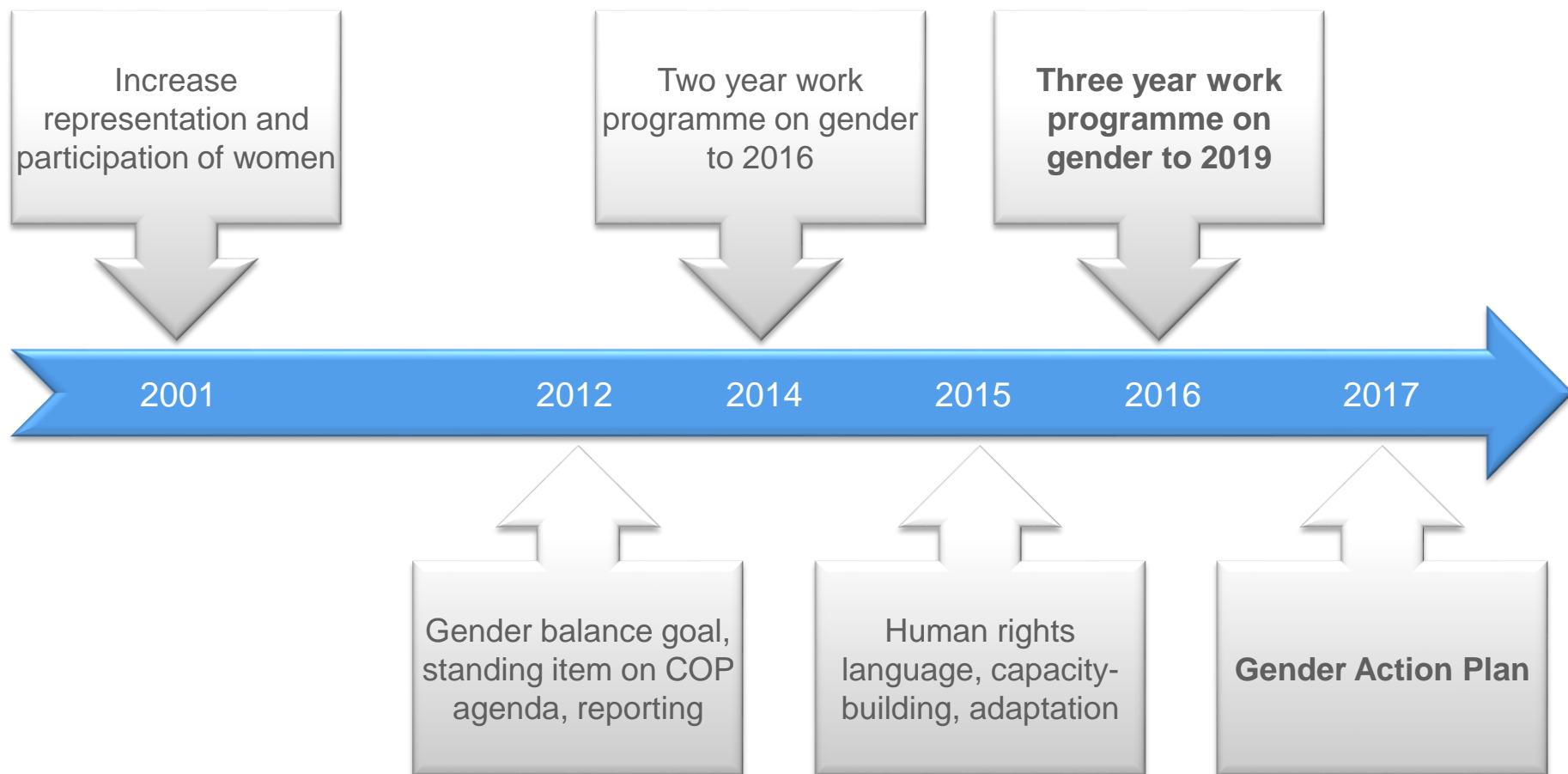


Gender equality and the empowerment of women and girls is undoubtedly a rights issue

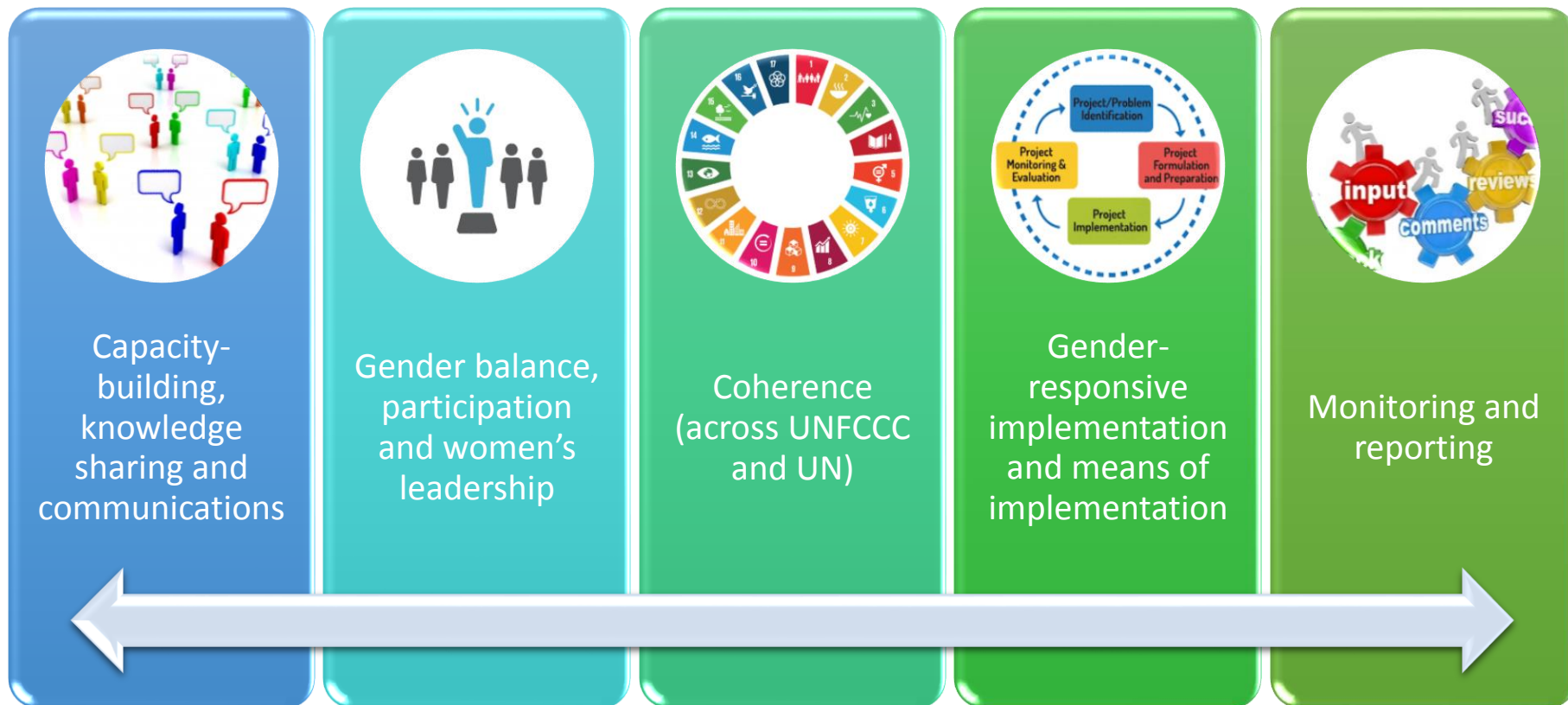

Capacity-building, knowledge sharing and communication

- ✓ Enhancing the understanding and expertise of stakeholders on the systematic integration of gender considerations ... in the thematic areas under the Convention and the Paris Agreement and in policies, programmes and projects on the ground



Gender balance, participation and women's leadership

- ✓ To achieve and sustain the full, equal and meaningful participation of women in the UNFCCC process



Coherence (in UNFCCC, across UN)

- ✓ To strengthen the integration of gender considerations within the work of UNFCCC bodies, the secretariat and other United Nation entities and stakeholders towards the consistent implementation of gender-related mandates and activities



Gender-responsive implementation and means of implementation

- ✓ To ensure the respect, promotion and consideration of gender equality and the empowerment of women in the implementation of the Convention and the Paris Agreement



Monitoring and reporting

- ✓ To improve tracking in relation to the implementation of and reporting on gender-related mandates under the UNFCCC
