Sergio A. Pombo is the Head of Private Equity Funds at the Green Climate Fund (GCF).

The GCF is the only climatic fund with a private sector facility established within the framework of the UNFCCC to assist developing countries in adaptation and mitigation practices to counter climate change.

Before GCF, Sergio co-founded Berkana Private Equity, LLC, a US-registered limited liability company that invests in clean energy and energy efficiency projects in Latin America.

Prior to managing Berkana, he was a Senior Investment Officer covering funds globally with the International Finance Corporation's (IFC) Private Equity and Investment Funds, in Washington, DC for 17 years. He co-established the largest global private equity conference (EMPEA-IFC PE conference).

Prior to IFC, he worked for the European Bank (EBRD) in London in the capacity of a Principal Manager, Financial Policy and Strategic Planning. He participated in the 1997 capitalization of the Bank.

Sergio has a BSc. Industrial Engineering degree from Pontifical Xavierian University. He holds an MBA degree from American University of Washington, DC, and received a Private Equity and Venture Capital certificate from Harvard's Business School (HBS), Executive Program. Sergio serves on the Board of several global private equity funds.
