Erin Roberts is a Research Associate in the Risk and Resilience Programme at the Overseas Development Institute where her work focuses on providing linkages between research, decision makers and international policy processes.

She works on several projects for ODI including Building Resilience and Adaptation to Climate Extremes and Disasters (BRACED), Pathways to Resilience in Semi-arid Economies (PRISE) and a collaboration between ODI, the Stockholm Environment Institute (SEI) and the Institute for Sustainable Development and International Relations (IDDRI) on transboundary adaptation.

As part of her work Erin follows the adaptation, loss and damage and finance discussions under the UNFCCC and is also engaged in projects on the ground.

Previously she coordinated a research project in Bangladesh and has also been involved in work to build resilience in the African small island developing states.

Alongside her work Erin is currently completing a PhD at King's College, London where her research focuses on the role of leadership in climate policies in Bangladesh and Senegal.
