Ms Liza Leclerc joined the International Fund for Agricultural Development (IFAD) as the Lead Technical Specialist on Environment and Climate Finance in the Environment and Climate Division in November 2017.

She joined IFAD from the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change Secretariat, in Germany, where she has been working as Team Leader. She led the political and technical work of the secretariat on the delivery of climate finance. Prior to this, she worked as a Senior Climate Change Adaptation and Risk Management Consultant for a number of International Financial Institutions and governments. She was also the Task Manager for the Adaptation Portfolio at UNEP in Kenya, and was the Acting Head of the Climate Change Unit at the Canadian International Development Agency and lead negotiator.

Ms. Leclerc holds a Master's Degree Business Administration from Warwick University and a Bachelor's of Science Degree in Natural Resource Management from the University of Toronto and was recently a lead author of the report of the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change.
