Saliha Dobardzic is Senior Climate Change Specialist with the Adaptation Fund.

Prior to this position, she was a Senior Climate Change Specialist with the Global Environment Facility's climate change adaptation program, namely the Least Developed Countries Fund and Special Climate Change Fund, where she was involved in strategic, technical, and policy aspects of the \$1.4 billion program portfolio.

Previously, Ms. Dobardzic worked on environmental, international waters, and integrated coastal zone management issues with the World Bank's MENA region.

She has also supported the World Bank's MENA climate change team in devising and implementing the first corporate climate change strategy for the region, and the Global Facility for Disaster Risk Reduction in support of mainstreaming climate change considerations in ex-ante disaster risk management.

Her experience also includes stints with the UN-Habitat in Nairobi, The Smithsonian Conservation and Research Center, and a number of prominent NGOs, in the private sector in the United States and abroad, as well as the World Bank's country office in post-conflict Bosnia, of which she is a national.
