







NDC Update Process was plural and inclusive

23 goals, for the six elements of ACE, with a global goal for: "Developing and implementing an Action for Climate Empowerment National Strategy."







Example of inclusion of principles of ACE and other cross-cutting issues on the NDC Action Plan

OBJECTIVE

1

PROMOTE the development of **policies, plans and regulations** for the sectoral implementation of the NDC.

Food Safety

Climate-Smart livestock management is promoted in the Dominican Republic to mitigate climate change and restore degraded lands.

IMPLEMENTING GOALS

MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE

- Program to increase the productivity of DR dairy herds (best grass options promotion and improvement) with climatically adaptable species.
- Arborization program, live fences and spontaneous regeneration with native species.

Indicators:

Percentage of extension, awareness and technical assistance program with the incorporation of a gender responsive and inclusive approach to milk and meat producers (MEGALECHE) achieved.

Number of hectares in properties of men and women intervened.

Number of beneficiary producers, disaggregated by age and sex in intervened farms

Number of heads of cattle adapted to changes in climate.
