What's next for climate action after the GST?

Technology is a powerful mean to enhance a transition towards a low carbon model. But we need to ensure that technology is connected to nature necessities and limits.

It means reducing the costs, providing the infrastructures and facilitating the knowledge to use it. The results of the GST must encourage us to use science to develop best practices.

It is not only a tool to empower nature but also people.
Technology must be accessible to all.

We need to comply with the 1.5°C limit.

To do so, mitigation and changing our model of society are paramount, but inclusion and equity are also essentials.

To think what's next there are 3 key challenges:

How to move towards systems transformation in a fair and inclusive way? How to reduce implementation gaps? What are the best forms of cooperation, accompaniment and empowerment?

The GST will bring down its results in few months.

What will happen next is the biggest preoccupation for climate action.

To implement effective climate actions,

we need to use the results of the GST and to particularly build on 2 related key factors: capacities and technologies.

TOOLS FAILS TECHNOLOGY

Empowerment is a tipping factor for ambitious climate actions. We need education and support for all. It has multiples co-benefits on growth and eradication of poverty.

A just and inclusive transition can only be based on local actions and be minded of most vulnerable communities that also have a lot to offer on how to create another model of society.

Building capacities must be both a possitive and active process. The GST will identify the major issues people need to work on to reduce emissions and what is lacking concern.



Hence, with the results of the GST we all need:

To value active listening, dialogue and sharing of cultures, experiences and voices.

To cooperate and collaborate even more between actors, sectors and levels outside of the idea of competition.

To open up our actions to even more people at ground level.

To move up the action, we need loud and clear messages addressed to people.

Simple language, visual contents, impacting stories, clear and accessible steps to follow will path the way to better climate action after the GST.
