• Decision 3/CMA.3:

- a) Paragraph 5(a): requested the Supervisory Body to develop provisions for the development and approval of methodologies, validation, registration, monitoring, verification and certification, issuance, renewal, first transfer from the mechanism registry, voluntary cancellation (...);
- b) Paragraph 62 of the annex (RMPs): Stakeholders, activity participants and participating Parties may **appeal decisions** of the Supervisory Body or request that a **grievance be addressed** by an independent grievance process.

• Decision 7/CMA.4:

a) Paragraph 23: requested the Supervisory Body to develop and operationalize a procedure for requesting transition of activities from the clean development mechanism to Article 6.4 mechanism by no later than June 2023.



Regulatory documents approved by the Supervisory Body

• Standards:

- a) <u>Transition of CDM activities to the Article 6.4 mechanism</u>; Sets out required activity design and other attributes of CDM projects, PoAs and CPAs for the transition to the Article 6.4 mechanism.
- b) Article 6.4 activity standard for projects; Sets out requirements relating to the design, implementation and other attributes of A6.4 projects.
- c) Article 6.4 validation and verification standard for projects;

Provides DOEs the minimum requirements for validation, post-registration and renewal of the crediting period of an A6.4 project, and the verification of GHG emission reductions or net GHG removals.

Procedures

- a) <u>Transition of CDM activities to the Article 6.4 mechanism;</u> Sets out procedural steps for CDM projects, PoAs and CPAs to transition to the Article 6.4 mechanism.
- b) Article 6.4 activity cycle procedure for projects; Describes the administrative steps to follow for the pre-registration, registration, postregistration change and renewal of the crediting period of projects, and pre-issuance and issuance of GHG emission reductions or net GHG removals.
- c) Appeals and grievance procedure;

Describes the administrative steps to follow to file an appeal against a decision of the Supervisory Body, submit a grievance against an A6.4 project and to process appeals and

grievances.







































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Procedure: Appeal and grievance processes under the Article 6.4 mechanism

- Appeal can be filed by the DNA of a host Party or by the DNA of any participating Party:
 - Approval or rejection of a request for registration of a project or a programme of activities (PoA), or for the inclusion of a component project (CP) in a PoA;
 - b) Approval or rejection of a request for approval of a post-registration change to a project, PoA or CP;
 - c) Approval or rejection of a request for issuance;
 - Approval or rejection of a request for renewal of the crediting period or PoA period, or for a notification of renewal of the crediting period of a CP
 - e) The application of Party-specific elements of methodological products that are applicable to that host Party.
