

- Host Parties through DNAs are at the center of implementing the Article 6.4 mechanism.
- SB007 agreed to prepare a note summarizing the roles and responsibilities of host Parties in various stages of the activity cycle.
- SB010 considered and agreed to further update the information note.
- SBM011 agreed to prepare a comprehensive and user-friendly guide or manual that will consider the views of host Party DNAs, for consideration of the Supervisory Body at its thirteenth meeting.



Information notes: Roles and responsibilities of host Parties

- RMPs and the various regulations adopted by the Supervisory Body.
- Activity cycle





Continued

- Division of roles and responsibilities
 - 1) Participation requirements: a host Party must fulfil to participate;
 - 2) Methodological responsibilities and potential roles: influence a host Party may have over the methodologies of activities in its jurisdiction;
 - **3)** Activity-specific responsibilities and potential roles: a host Party to approve specific activities within its jurisdiction;
 - 4) Functional roles, where the host Party plays a functional role in a process under the Article 6.4 mechanism. They are not necessarily between the host Party and SB and may or may not relate to a specific step in the activity cycle.



Guide or manual to be prepared

- Comprehensive and user-friendly guide or manual
- Prepared based on the existing Information note.
- Implications of host Parties' participation on NDCs achievement, LT-LEDS, and potential net-zero commitments.
- Other elements such as FAQs, template..etc.
- DNAs input will be taken into account before considered by the SBM013
