Breakout Discussions

Lessons in incorporating Just Transition into NDCs, NAPs and LT-LEDS

All 3 thematic breakout discussions will run in parallel. Participants will be assigned to one of the three breakout discussion rooms and stay in the room throughout the day. Over the course of the day, all participants will be able to attend each discussion.

Each breakout discussion will run for approximately 60 minutes with a short break in between to allow facilitators to switch between breakout discussion rooms. Facilitators will keep time and inform Participants about the program.

Guiding Questions:

Breakout Discussion 1: Inclusive approaches to the development of NDCs, NAPs and LT-LEDS and other policies (Identifying and engaging stakeholders)

- How are Parties adopting an inclusive and participatory approach that leaves no one behind in developing their NDCs, NAPs and LT-LEDS?
- What measures can ensure that people in vulnerable situations benefit from the opportunities of the just transition and that NDCs/NAPs/LT-LEDS leverage their role as agents of change, while also minimizing risks?



Breakout Discussion 2: Experience in incorporating Just Transition pathways into NDCs, NAPs and LT-LEDS (Analysis, policy development & lessons learned)

- Which practices/frameworks/strategies and related governance mechanisms have been helpful to incorporating just transition pathways into NDCs, NAPs, and LT-LEDS and in your view should inform the next round of NDCs/NAPs/LT-LEDS?
- What have been key challenges or pitfalls? What kind of assessments and diagnostics helped to include just transition considerations in the NDCs/LT-LEDS/NAPs? What kind of assessments and diagnostics are useful to give effect to just transition considerations that were included in the NDCs/NAPs/LT-LEDS?

Breakout Discussion 3: Policy coherence for implementing just transitions pathways (Enabling implementation)

- How can just transitions pathways be effectively mainstreamed in implementing NDCs/NAPs/LT-LEDS?
