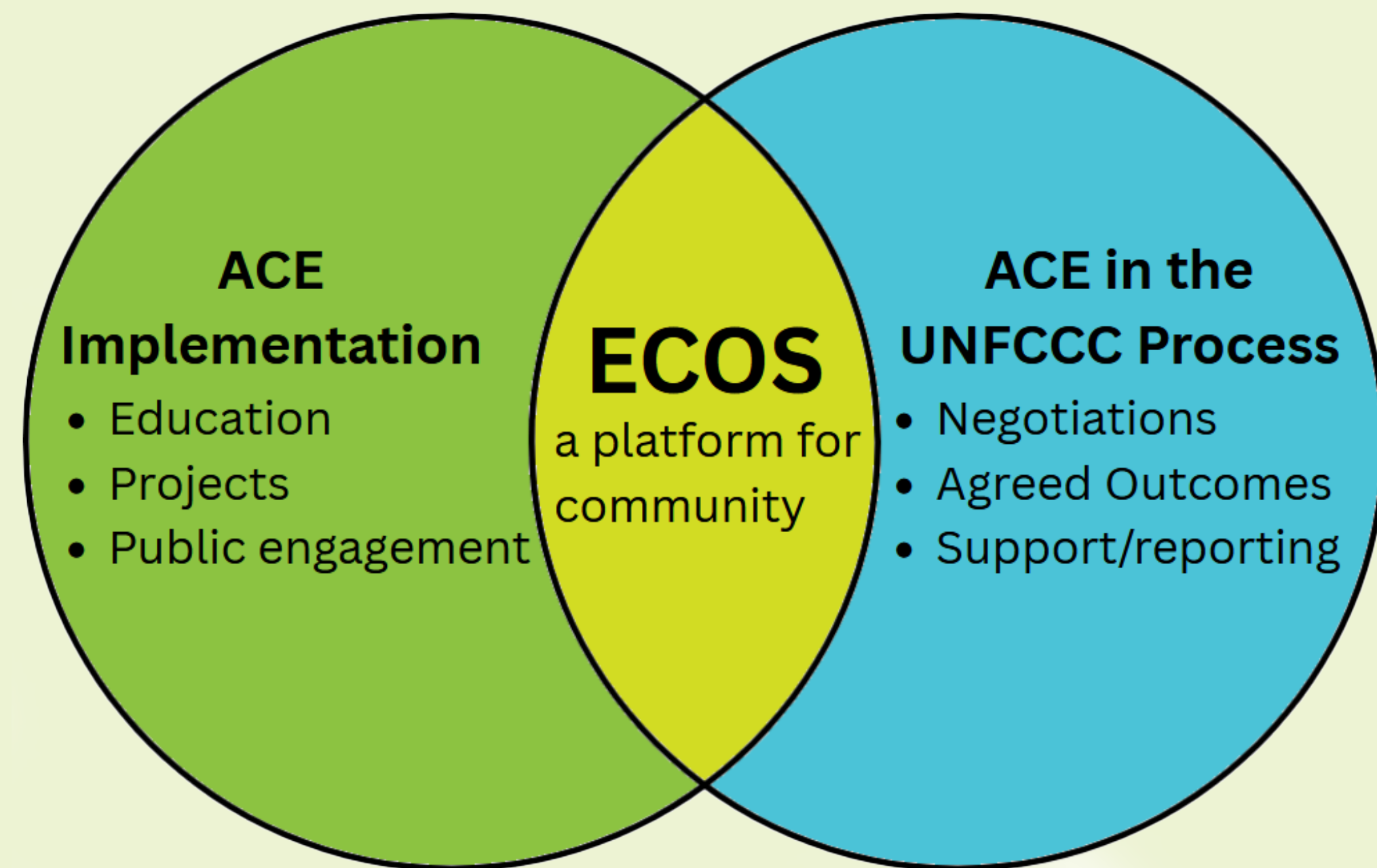




EDUCATION, COMMUNICATION, AND OUTREACH STAKEHOLDER COMMUNITY (ECOS)

We are a community officially recognized by the UNFCCC Secretariat as the “informal group” for education, communication, and outreach stakeholders. ECOS thereby provides a platform for these actors to engage collectively with the UN climate process, while also serving as a space to foster networking, collaboration, and capacity-building for anyone working within the broad umbrella of Action for Climate Empowerment (ACE).

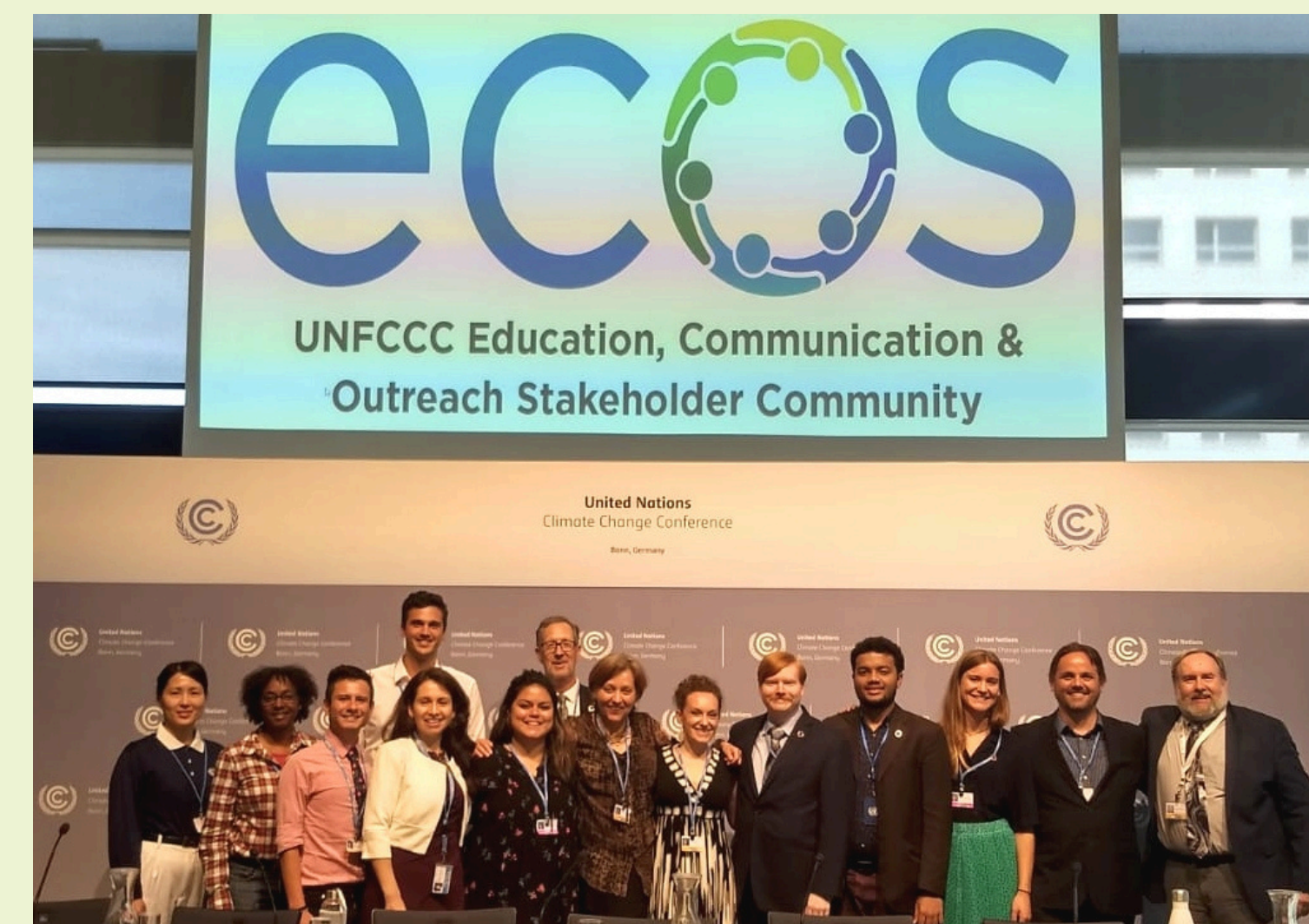


Our goals:
