Parties

What?
We help countries understand the potential for ambitious mitigation and adaptation action while identifying and responding to their needs.

How?
By establishing necessary arrangements to ensure adequate financial flows, technology transfer, capacity-building and development.

NGOs

What?
The ETF offers new opportunities for cooperation and engagement to build trust around the process.

How?
By providing access to better and more consistent data to inform conversations on progress on mitigation, adaptation and means of implementation and support.

Media

What?
Climate communication plays a key role in raising awareness, explaining the complexity of climate change and shedding light on climate action.

How?
By generating, sharing and analysing reliable data which increases accountability of all countries in meeting their Paris Agreement goals.

Experts

What?
Experts develop detailed reports including accurate data and information on GHG emissions, progress toward targets and levels of support.

How?
Through reporting and review of transparency reports of Parties, experts ensure the completeness and consistency of information reported.

Youth

What?
Young people want certainty about their future and the future of the planet. They want to explore, collaborate and partake in climate action.

How?
By offering the opportunity to improve their understanding of climate change, advocating for intergenerational equity and influence decision-makers for greater ambition.

IGOs

What?
Intergovernmental organisations, UN agencies and other multilateral institutions contribute to greater transparency of international climate actions.

How?
By strengthening institutional and national capacities to generate and analyse robust climate data.

Business

What?
Transparency helps businesses track progress toward achieving their net zero pledges and climate targets.

How?
By helping them to make sound investment choices, improve efficiency, reduce GHG emissions, identify and address risks and align financial flows.
