



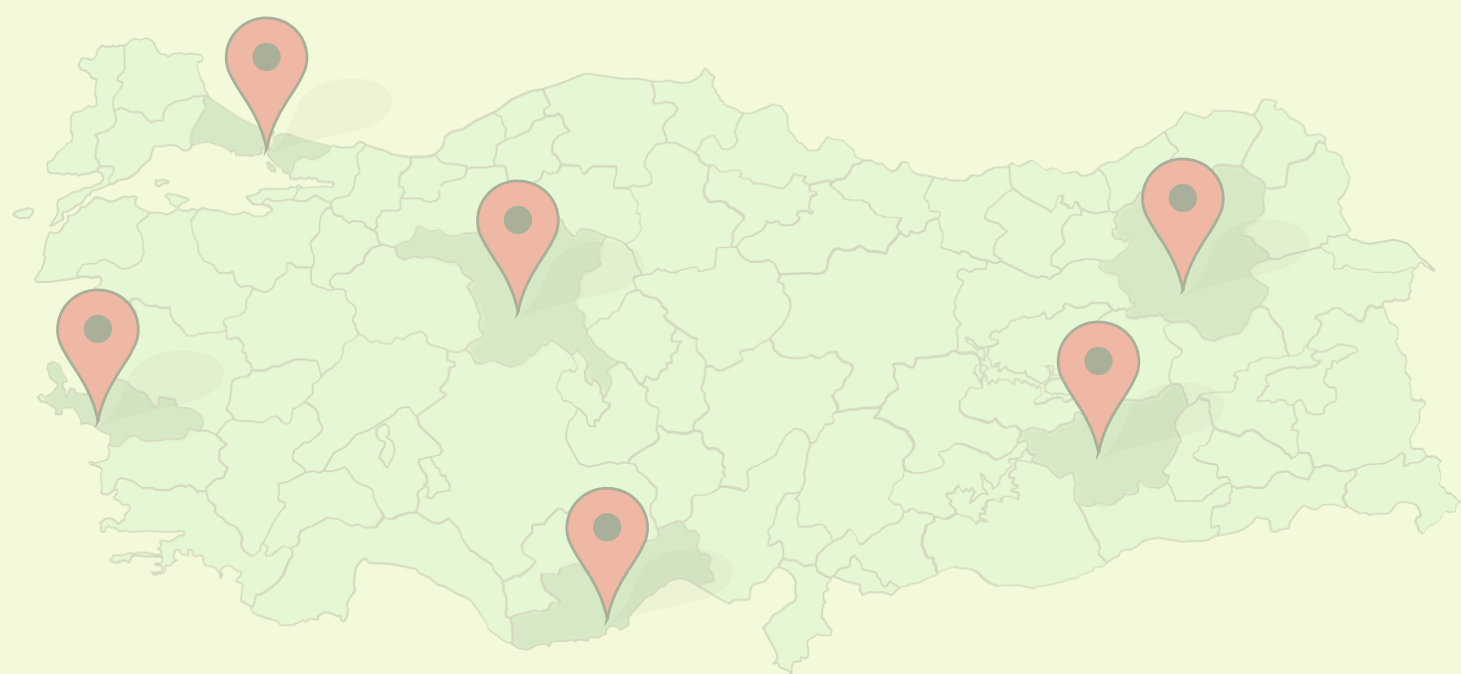
Introduction

The training programme titled 'Climate Change, Disaster and First Aid' was implemented in six provinces across Türkiye in cooperation with the Ministry of National Education of the Republic of Türkiye and the World Bank.

The programme targeted 9th grade students and aimed to raise awareness and develop skills related to climate change, disaster preparedness and basic first aid.

This programme aligned with the Climate Change Action Plan of the Ministry of National Education, which serves as a national roadmap aiming to integrate climate awareness, disaster risk reduction and sustainability into all levels of education. The programme equipped both students and educators with the necessary knowledge and skills to respond to the climate crisis, be prepared for emergencies and develop environmentally responsible behaviours. The 'Climate Change, Disaster and First Aid' programme contributed directly to the implementation of this vision through hands-on learning.

In addition, this training supported the adoption of more conscious lifestyles for future generations by strengthening environmental awareness and enhancing society's resilience to risks, in line with the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals.
