


Key facts

- Government and multi-stakeholder initiative **launched at COP22** gathering countries with interest on long-term strategies and ambition
- Hosted by the European Climate Foundation
- Funded by philanthropy and public funds
- 36 member countries, but working with many more non-member countries to support LTS
 - Members in the region include: Argentina, Brazil, Chile, Colombia, Costa Rica, Honduras, Jamaica, Mexico, Peru
- Bringing together a network of donors, international and national think tanks, and climate policy experts on long term planning
- Granting governments, local analytical organizations, local stakeholders, and global think-tanks

Capacity building









- Conduct training and workshops with government officials and key stakeholders to increase understanding of the main elements and approaches to developing an LTS
- Commission global knowledge products to address needs and questions raised by countries in relation to their LTS
- Support technical teams in charge of LTS elaboration to share best practice and lessons from other countries

Knowledge and advisory









- Organise annual meetings to bring together governments, donors and other others to discuss different elements of LTS
- Facilitate connections with international experts on longterm planning to address specific country needs
- Provide advice and assistance to governments developing their LTS, including for increasing the reach of their LTS to international audiences, particularly donors

Financial support









- Bring together relevant donors to fund the successful development and operationalisation of LTS
- Provide when possible financial grants to governments for the development of LTS. The support can be targeted e.g., in-country coordinator and project management, stakeholder consultations, modelling, communications etc.
