Towards Responsible Use of Plastics: Reduce, Reuse, Recycle

CEE designed and developed a school kit containing a teacher's manual, a set of three bilingual posters and a student's manual.

Translated in 11 different languages and disseminated across various schools of India. The kit provides information about 'Reduce and Reuse' and 'Handprint Activities' towards their responsible use as part of a sustainable lifestyle.
