This includes supporting inclusive engagement and participation in climate action by communicating authoritative, relevant and timely information to Parties and non-Party stakeholders.






RCCs 2024 | Areas of Work

In 2024, all RCCs shared common core priorities aiming to support countries in implementing the Paris Agreement. These included the co-organization and delivery of capacity building and knowledge sharing activities, the provision of technical assistance, efforts to grow regional collaborative networks, with a priority to support:

the development and implementation of NDCs, focusing on NDC3.0

the operationalization of Article 6 of the Paris Agreement

the development of carbon pricing instruments

the formulation and implementation of NAPs

This work undertaken in collaboration with partners included major activities such as:
