Four improvements requested for NMA Platform: new country filters (incl. SIDS); expanded sectors drop-down menu; optional section on type of approach; all countries fully visible on map

Decision 13/CMA.7 (Mitigation Work Programme)

SBSTA requested to consider additional NMA Platform functionalities to enable the recording of MWP projects and interconnection with other platforms

No NMA Platform developments undertaken since GCNMA 8 – risked inefficiency if a further round of similar technical updates was requested under the work programme review

Review of the work programme (SBSTA 64)

All NMA Platform developments to be considered under the work programme review (separate agenda item to GCNMA 9)
