INDONESIA'S VIEWS ON WAYS OF ENHANCING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF ACE AND REVIEW OF THE DOHA WORK PROGRAMME

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7 Years of the Doha Work Programme

- The Doha Work programme has successfully provide a deliberation of Article 6 of the Convention and a framework for country-driven action addressing the specific needs and circumstances of Parties and reflecting their national priorities and initiatives
- The Doha Work Programme has provided a platform for exchange of experiences, lessons learned and best practices in the areas of climate change education, training, public awareness, public participation, public access to information, and international cooperation.

Post 2020: after the review

- The Doha work programme or its continuation should be able to increase integration and synchronization of the 6 thematic areas with climate change policy and strategy.
- With regards ways of enhancing the implementation of Action for Climate Empowerment (ACE) after the adoption of the Katowice Climate Package, developing countries should identify requirements for building their capacities in mitigation and adaptation actions in order to achieve their global pledges through their Nationally Determined Contributions (NDCs).

Identified Needs and Possible Actions

- High level political support through integration of climate change policy in the national development planning, education and financial system.
- Taking into account the aspect of gender in the implementation of ACE.
- Climate change as one of national research priority.

Interlinkages and Synergies

- Elaboration of the implementation of ACE not limited to the regular triple-helix concept (government business academic), adopting the concept of Pentahelix (involving also community/grassroot including NGO, and the media).
- Increasing the role of non party stakeholders in the achievement of Nationally Determined Contribution;
- International academic partnership to promote the development of national capacity with international standard;
- Students as agents of change.
