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




NAP – Specifics Objetctives






Example:



Environmental, socioeconomic, demographic, water use and climate variables (2 global models + 2 RCP)










> MANY IMPORTANT STUDIES ABOUT IMPACT AND VULNERABILITY TO SUPPORT THE ADAPTATION AGENDA

Brazilian National Centre for Monitoring and Early Warning of Natural Disasters (Cemaden)

More than 4750 rain gauges, 300 fluviometers, 100 agrometeorological gauges, 9 meteorological radars, etc. Monitoring of 958 of the most vunerable municipalities +8000 mapped risk areas (about 10.000.000 people) +40 PhDs and +40 MsC



Project Rain Gauges in Communities








CURRENT IMPACTS + FUTURE IMPACTS RELATED TO CLIMATE CHANGES

BASELINE (1961-1990)






