# Economic diversification

---

Findings from 2018 NWP Focal Point Forum on economic diversification

- ❖ Anchored in scientific information to assess needs and explore options
- ❖ Enabling environments allow communities to pilot, replicate, sustain and scale up
- ❖ Centred on, owned, driven and managed by the affected community
- ❖ Public receptiveness to change
- ❖ Willingness to invest
- ❖ Builds on local knowledge and experience
- ❖ Understanding of market needs and option
- ❖ Allowing new and existing partnerships to evolve
- ❖ Supported by 'outside the box' thinking, combined with market and technological innovation
- ❖ Underpinned by a holistic and integrated risk management approach



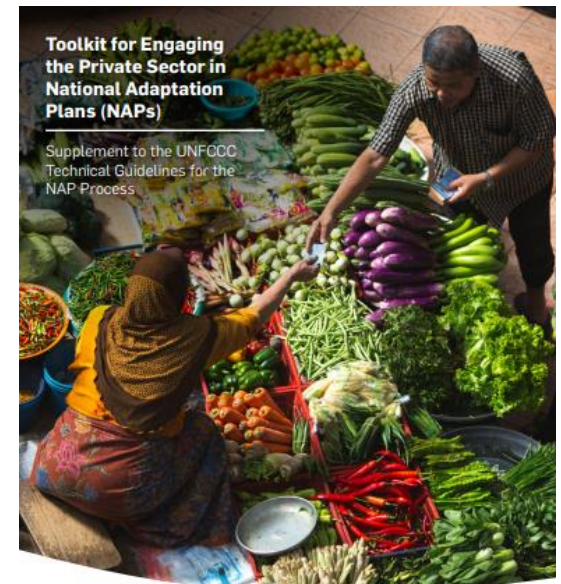
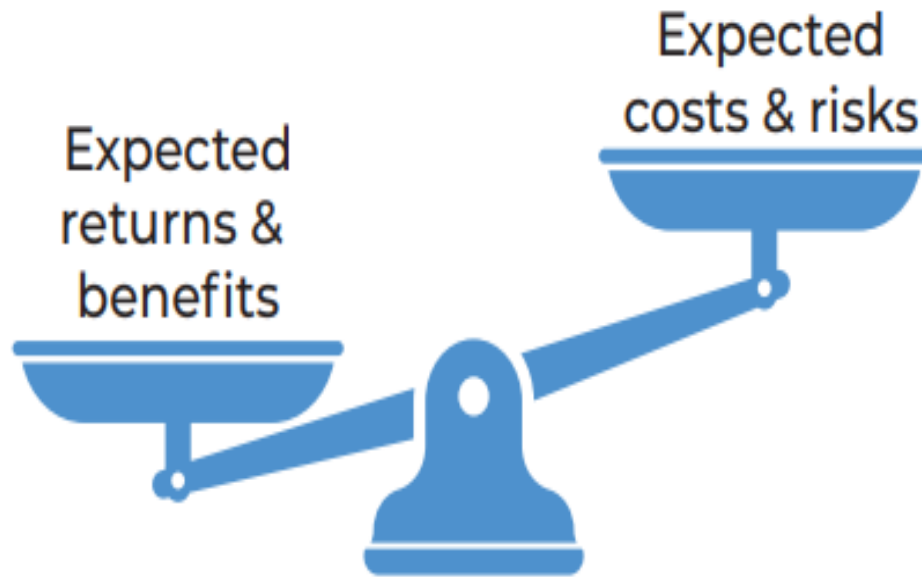
# NWP work on agriculture

# Linkages between adaptation and mitigation

---

- ❖ Inter-relations across sectors and UN organizations/agencies
- ❖ Synergetic movement - system innovation and societal transformation for ambitious mitigation and adaptation
- ❖ Ecosystems, agriculture, energy, infrastructure: adaptation co-benefits for mitigation
- ❖ Energy, forests, agriculture, urban planning: mitigation co-benefits for adaptation
- ❖ Minimizing trade offs: stakeholder engagement, incl. local communities; project design and implementation
- ❖ Synergies at project, sector or landscape level, and at national, regional or local, urban and rural levels.
