# Chile's NDC update process



## **Contribution to Paris Agreement in development and capacity strengthening** (2015)

- 4.2.1 Elaboration of projection models that Chile can share and spread nationally and internationally, with both individual and joint efforts with other countries available.
- 4.2.2 Seminars carried out jointly along with those countries willing to provide support for training and capacity building for countries that require it in the preparation and communication of its intended national contributions, emission inventories of greenhouse gases, national communications, biennial update reports and Nationally Appropriate Mitigation Actions (NAMAs).
- 4.2.3 The development of instruments to promote research and capacity building at national and sub-national level, strengthening the response capacity of communities and local governments, in order to strengthen national adaptive capacity, through institutional development and strengthening the capacities of those groups and sectors of the country that are most vulnerable to the impacts of climate change.



# **How does Chile implement NDC?**

The National Action Plan of Climate Change (PANCC) includes a chapter of "means of implementation", its object is to implement transversal elements that complement measures proposed in the Mitigation, Adaptation and Territorial actions related to institutional strengthening, technology transfer, capacity building and technical assistance, financing and international negotiation.

# Development and capacity strengthening proposal under NDC



- Research on climate change
- Education and sensitization of citizens to address climate change
- Creation and strengthening of national, regional and local capacities for climate change management
- Promoting the exchange of experiences at the national and regional level on mitigation and adaptation measures to climate change at the local level

Considers 6 pilar of ACE: education, training, public awareness, public access to information, public participation, international cooperation

	Elaboration of material (Expert based)
Training	Online courses by Adriana Hoffman Academy
	Actions in sectorial plans (Different national institutions)
Public awareness	Workshops, seminars
Public access to information	Transparency Law.
Public participation	Each policy considers a voluntary public participation process (online formal and workshops)

- It is necessary to articulate ACE actions from public, private, academy, civil society sectors, in particular for reports.
- NDC update need to integrate capacity building focused in mitigation and adaptation compromises, considering in its whole process the Action for Climate Empowerment.
