Results in Least Developed Countries and Small Island Developing States



- **35 countries** – were supported to strengthen their capacity related to Early Warning Systems
- **150+ National Meteorological and Hydrological Services staff** - were trained in a wide range of activities: Impact Based Forecasting, Severe Weather, Flash Floods, Common Alerting Protocol, Regional Climate Data, Analysis and Projections
- **14 countries** - developed **National Strategies and Frameworks** for Weather, Water and Climate Services
- **12 countries** - Conducted **National Assessments** of MHEWS
- **9 countries** – developed “**Met Bills**” providing legal mandates for NMHSs
- **3 regional** and **3 national Impact-based Forecasting workshops** and training sessions
- **4 Community-based EWS** were developed
- NMHSs received assistance to participate in **Regional and national climate outlook forums** in all 3 geographic areas
