# Philippines' Nationally Determined Contribution

## Commitment<sup>1</sup>:

A projected GHG emissions reduction and avoidance of **75%**, of which 2.71% is unconditional and 72.29% is conditional, representing the country's ambition for GHG mitigation for the period 2020 to 2030 for the sectors of **agriculture, wastes, industry, transport, and energy**.

- ❖ provides a conservative estimate of the investment requirements to deliver the country's NDC targets amounting to USD72 billion

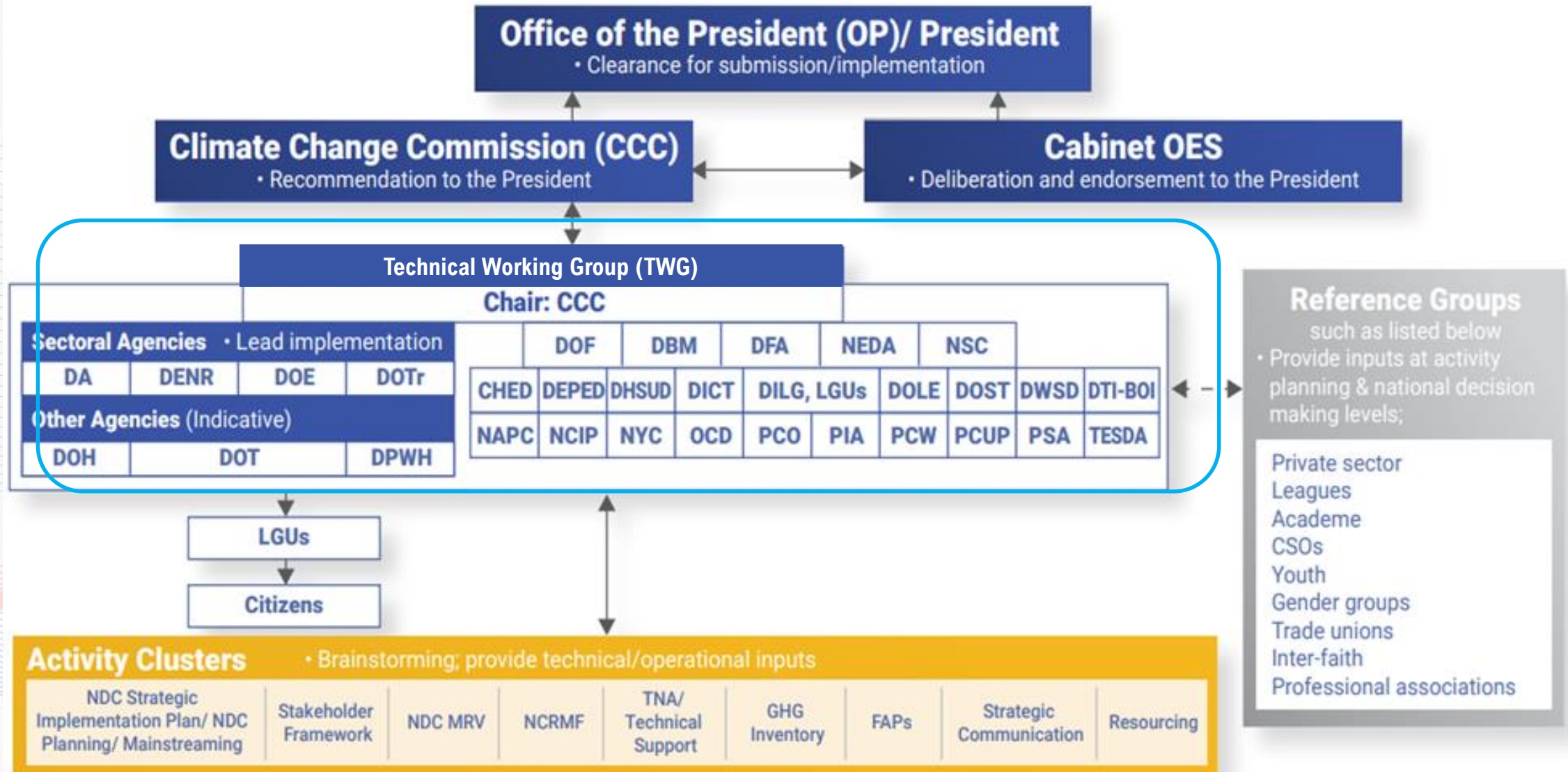

## **The Philippines' NDC Implementation Plan (NDCIP)**

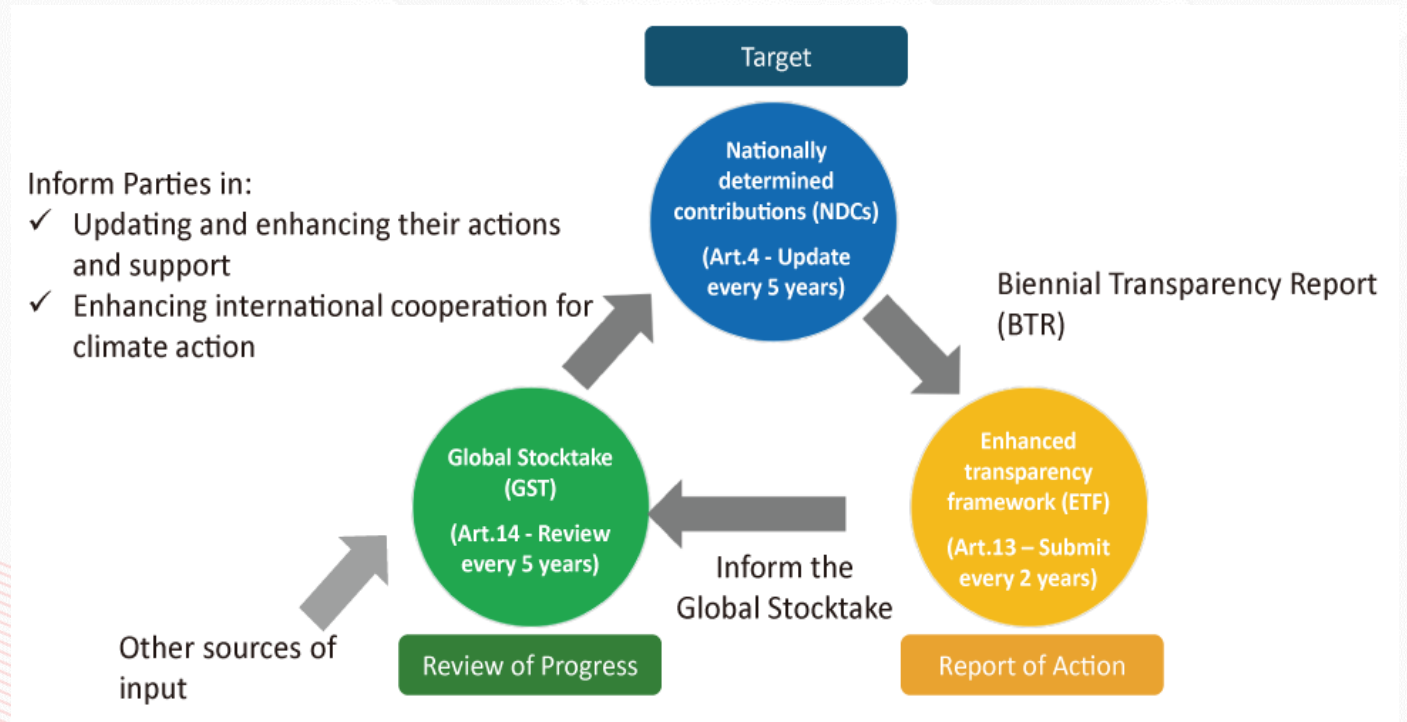
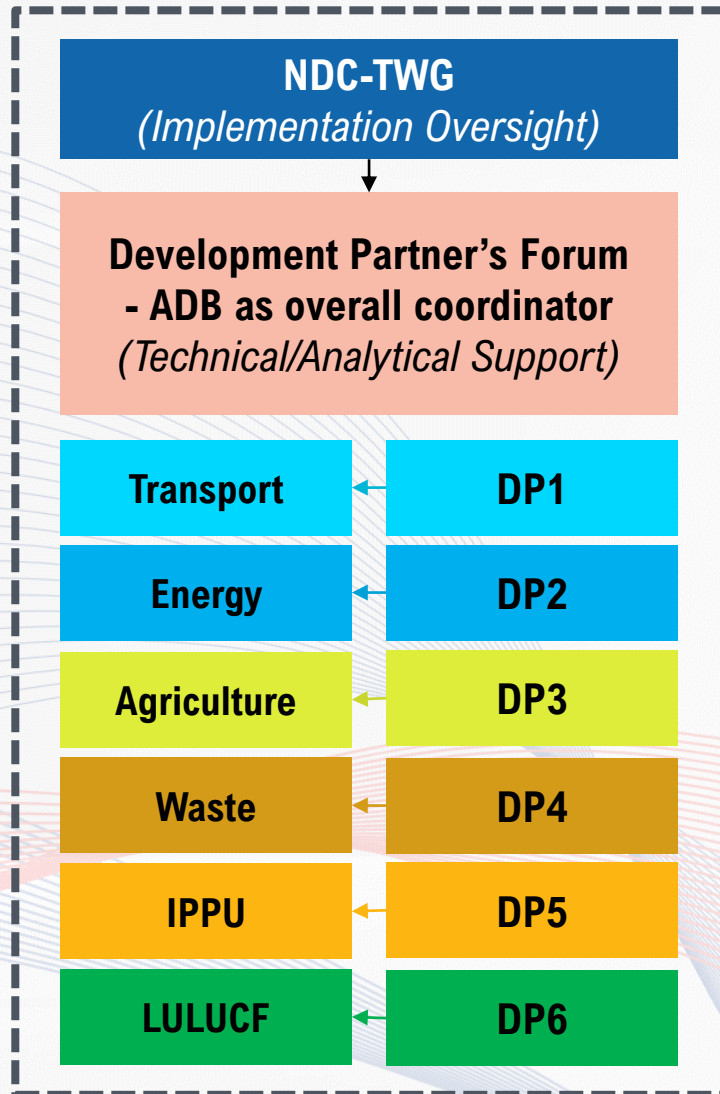
- ❖ Developed through a whole-of-government, whole-of-society, and whole-of-nation approach
